Code of Conduct Form For 2023 Prom

Turn this form in on the day of your ticket purchase.

Deadline to purchase tickets is **Tuesday, March 14th.**

To ensure that prom is an event that everyone enjoys, please obey the following rules.

1. TCS is a tobacco/vape/drug/alcohol-free campus. It shall be a violation of policy for any student of TCS to possess, consume, display, or sell any tobacco products, tobacco-related devices, electronic cigarettes, drug products, drug-related devices, alcohol or alcohol-related products, or alcohol devices at any time on school property. TCS retains the right to define said tobacco/vape/drug/alcohol products and devices. The term school property means all facilities and property, including land, whether owned, rented, or leased by TCS, and all vehicles owned, leased, rented, contracted for, or controlled by TCS for use in transporting students, staff, or visitors.
2. In order for students and guests to attend prom, TCS students must attend half of their classes on the day of prom.
3. No improper behavior, including indecent dancing and inappropriate language including singing explicit lyrics which have been intentionally eliminated in order to foster TCS's commitment to Christian conduct.
4. Once a student or guest exits prom, they may not re-enter. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Students must remain in designated prom areas at all times. When attendees exit the door of the prom, they must leave the premises. Loitering is prohibited.
5. In order to enter prom, students and guests **MUST** follow our provided "Dress Code Guidelines".
6. Please make sure that social media posts do not create a false representation of our prom attire dress code. Per the TCS handbook: "We expect good judgment in all situations. Behave in a way that will make you and others proud and reflect well on the school. Regardless of your privacy settings, assume that all of the information you have shared on your social network is public information." Please be advised that we will require the removal of social media posts that do not accurately reflect the prom attire dress code. Each student is a representative of our school both in-person and online.

Dress Code Guidelines

We want Prom to be a fun and memorable event for you. In order to achieve that, we all must do our part. Your part in this event is to choose an attire that is appropriate for a dance at Trinity Christian School.

For the Guys

This is a jacket and tie event for gentlemen which requires males to wear a suit jacket with a tie, a collared, button-up shirt, and loose-fitting dress pants. Shorts, jeans, extremely tight pants, or overly casual attire will not be permitted. Guys must keep shirts fully buttoned up throughout the dance.

For the Girls

1. Slits must be no higher than 3 inches above the knee.
2. Strapless dresses are permitted; however, they cannot show cleavage
3. No low necklines. If the back of the dress is open, it is permitted, as long as at least half of your back is covered.
4. Two-piece dresses must have no more than two fingers of space between the top and the skirt, even while hands are raised.
5. No large cut-outs at mid-section or sides of the dress.
6. No nude/skin tone underlay is allowed anywhere on the dress to create the illusion of see-through material.
7. Please wear appropriate undergarments: i.e. bra, slip shorts. Undergarments must not be seen through any clothing and must not be visible in color or by outline due to fit and material type.

Special Note:

This year, dresses will no longer be sent to TCS staff for approval. Instead, we are leaving dress decisions up to parents. If a TCS student is bringing a guest who is not a TCS student, we ask the TCS parent to ensure that the dress meets the dress code guidelines. With the clear guidelines provided, we are confident that parents can make informed decisions about what is appropriate. If students end up coming to prom with the unacceptable attire, we will have modesty panels and safety pins ready to help students meet dress code compliance before we permit students to enter. If modifications are not possible with these items, students will not be permitted into the dance. Please refrain from wearing dresses differently (i.e. without modesty panels or with more midriff showing, etc.) on social media platforms. Each student is a representative of our school both in-person and online. Please make sure that social media posts do not create a false representation of our prom attire dress code. Please be advised that we will require the removal of social media posts that do not accurately reflect the prom attire dress code.
