### AUTO-ENROLLMENT IN ADVANCED COURSES GRANT

## **Grant Application Opening Soon – Due Jan. 15**

The John W. Buckner Automatic Enrollment in Advanced Courses Grant is intended to increase the number of students enrolled in advanced courses for subjects in which the student has demonstrated proficiency. Approximately \$220,000 is available to be distributed among grantees for a one-year cycle, and funds can be used for high school or middle school (grades 4-8) students. The Fact Sheet for this program is available <a href="here">here</a> and FAQs are currently being developed.

The Request for Application (RFA) will be made available for reference at the end of October. Because this grant cycle will utilize CDE's new GAINS grant management system (see below), an Intent to Participate will be due January 8, 2024, and the application will be due in GAINS by January 15, 2024. These steps and timeline will also be published on the Auto-Enrollment website.

## **Educator Financial Aid Trainings**
