

Harry Hart Memorial KAEA Senior Scholarships

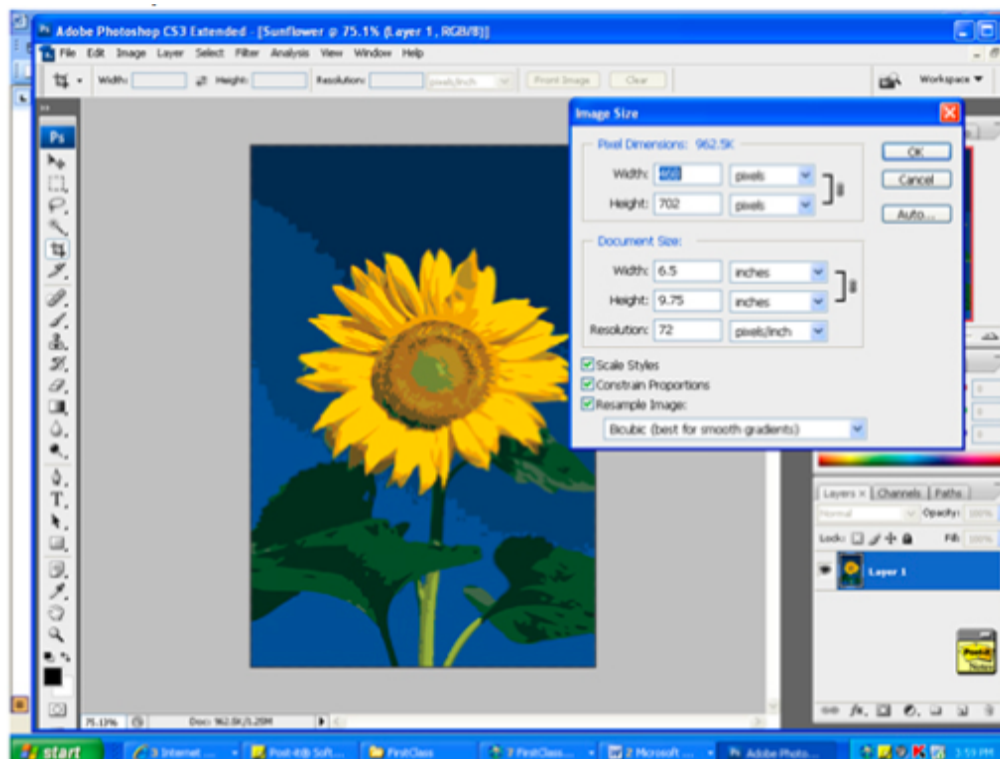
The Harry Hart Memorial Scholarships are named in honor of long-time KAEA member Harry Hart who passed away in 2009. The Kansas Art Education Association gives TWO \$500.00 scholarships each year and are paid directly to the Institutes of Higher Learning chosen by the winning student.

Guidelines

- Active K.A.E.A. members can submit ONE scholarship portfolio consisting of 3 pieces of art work.
- Students must be a Senior in good standing and have the intention of majoring in an art related field at an institution of higher learning.
- Portfolios must be submitted by the due date and in the correct format.
- Student portfolios must include a minimum of one piece created under the direct supervision of the nominating teacher.
- The same student can NOT be entered by two different teachers. This would be unfair as it would double the chances for a student to win.

Sizing your images:

In Photoshop, choose Image> Image size. (This step may vary if you are using other image editing software.) Change the resolution to 72 ppi. Pixel dimension sizes should be approximately a maximum of 780 x 530. (these numbers flip if your image is in landscape mode rather than portrait mode). File size should be less than 1 MB. To check the file size, you can right click on the image and look at the image properties at the bottom of the screen window. The image size may be approximately 6.5" x 9.75". The sample below is 962.5K.



Portfolio Requirements

- Portfolios may be created as a Powerpoint, Keynote or Google Slides document. Please use a simple format of either black or white background.

WHEN FINISHED- please save/export document as a PDF file.

- Portfolios will consist of 4 slides and 4 slides only.
- Slide 1 will list the students name (first initial, last name)
- Slides 2-4 will display the 3 pieces of artwork. If the piece is 3-dimensional, it can be shot at different angles and all images are shown on one slide.
- Each image slide should include a “text box” that includes:
 - Title of the Work
 - Medium
 - Size of the Work
- All information about the student and the teacher will be filled out on the excel template and then submitted as an attachment with the Powerpoint document.
- The Excel template and a sample portfolio can be found on the KAEA web page on the Harry Hart Scholarship page at <http://www.kaea.com/p/harry-hart.html>. Save a copy of the template into your excel program. Be sure to save the template as 1997-2003 version of excel.

 - PDF slide Portfolio consisting of 4 slides
