



## Associated Students General Elections

### Declaration of Intent to Form a Coalition

Coalitions must be recognized as temporary political organizations at the time of filing Petition for Candidacy forms. Coalitions must have a minimum of four candidates in the election. Any group of four or more candidates campaigning as a group are to be considered a coalition.

If a candidate is a member of a coalition, his/her individual expenditures shall be one-half of the amount stated in the A.S. Policy on Elections. Campaign funds may be jointly pooled by coalition members. All candidates (including coalitions) must turn in a statement to the Commissioner listing all expenses and donations. Donated materials will be reported at fair market value for the items or services.

*We, the below-signed candidates, wish to be recognized as a temporary political organization for the purpose of running for office as a coalition. We have read the Elections Code and understand the requirements and responsibilities to be a recognized temporary political organization.*
