Purchase Agreement / Health Guarantee

Thank you for choosing to purchase one of our puppies! We want to make this as stress-free and enjoyable as possible for you. Please feel free to call me with any questions or concerns that you might have along the way. We will keep you up to date with information and pictures until it is time for your puppy to come home. This contract is written for the protection of both the breeder and the buyer. Emphasis however, is placed on ensuring the health and well-being of each puppy sold.

Purchase Agreement

1. Please read the health guarantee completely before putting a deposit on a puppy. **By putting a deposit on a puppy, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions within this contract.**
2. We require a \$400 minimum deposit to hold a puppy. A deposit in the amount of \$_____ was placed for your puppy on (date) _____. **The \$400 portion of the deposit is non-refundable. If your chosen gender / color preference is not available in the litter your deposit is originally applied towards, it will be applied towards the next available litter.**
3. The total purchase price for my puppy is \$_____. This leaves the remaining balance due to be \$_____. The remaining amount due may be paid by the deposit method cash, or a cashier's check made out to Alexandra Campo. If your deposit method has fee's and you opt to change to a non-fee method for the balance, Breeder will provide screenshots to verify any fee's due to Buyer.
4. Deposits are accepted by a range of payment processors. Main payment types accepted but not limited to are Venmo, Zelle, cash, a cashier's check made out to Alexandra Campo, Good Dog, Pay Pal. If the payment type has fees associated with it, it is on the Buyer to cover all fees in addition to the payment amount above at the pick-up type marked below. Breeder will screenshot any fee's associated on the line below. The entire payment amount due at pick-up is the final amount above plus any fees below. I'm choosing to pay by: _____ Fee's: \$_____
5. The buyer understands that the deposit is to be sent within 24 hours after signing the contract otherwise Bluebonnet Pomsies reserves the right to terminate the contract if they see fit to do so.

6. You will be:

☐ Picking your puppy up in person. The remaining amount is due at or before receiving your puppy.

OR

☐ Having your puppy shipped to you either by air or ground transport. The remaining amount is due at least 2 days prior to the date your puppy is shipping out. Failure to complete payment at least 48 hours prior to the date of departure may cause delays in transport, to which the buyer accepts all fees, penalties, and costs associated with changing the shipment.

Health Guarantee

1. The buyer understands that their puppy comes with a standard **3 YEAR HEALTH GUARANTEE**.
2. Puppies will not go home before 8 weeks old. If the 8 week mark falls on a weekday, the buyer will have until Sunday evening that the puppy is 8 weeks old to pick-up without any additional charges for extra days. All pick-up's are by appointment only. Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing via e-mail, there is a \$30.00/day extra charge for a puppy staying longer than the end of the day on the Sunday that the puppy is 8 weeks old.
3. The puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of the sale. Breeder will have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian before the puppy leaves the Breeder's care.
4. The puppy will have been wormed and received at least it's first round of distemper and parvo vaccinations prior to going home. The buyer will receive this medical record with the puppy.
5. The buyer must have the puppy examined by their licensed veterinarian within **72 hours** of receiving the puppy. If the puppy is not seen by a licensed veterinarian of the buyers choosing within 72 hours of going home, **this contract becomes void**. **This is to ensure that the puppy is healthy for sale by an unbiased licensed professional for the protection of the buyer, the breeder, and that all parties agree that the puppy is indeed healthy for sale as deemed so by a licensed veterinarian.** This can be changed if done so in writing and signed by both the Breeder and the Buyer.
6. The buyer must submit documentation of the examination for the Health Guarantee to be honored which can be the receipt of services that shows some form of 'wellness exam' and the veterinarian's office.
7. If within 72 hours a Licensed Veterinarian finds the puppy to be unfit for sale, the buyer needs to contact the breeder immediately. The puppy may be returned for a full refund providing that the puppy has not been neglected or injured. The veterinarian must provide a written statement deeming why the puppy is

“unhealthy for purchase” and supporting evidence of the defects or medical issue. If all criteria has been met, the breeder will refund the buyer upon receipt of the puppy, minus any travel costs, for the purchase price of the puppy assuming the puppy has not been harmed or neglected in any way. If the puppy has been neglected or harmed in any way, the refund becomes void.

8. This guarantee does not cover any health issues caused by neglect or injury from the buyer.
9. **This guarantee is immediately void if the buyer uses Trifexis, NexGuard, Simparica, or any other oral flea/tick medication at any point in the puppy's life as they have been the cause of numerous health complications unrelated to the dog's breeding.** Other forms of oral heartworm and non-oral/ingested flea/tick prevention should be used.
10. This guarantee does not cover complications from, or being exposed to, heartworms, fleas or ticks.
11. The buyer is expected to use monthly treatment for heartworms, fleas and ticks, and receive an annual exam by a licensed veterinarian. Failure to do so will result in a void Health Guarantee.
12. The breeder assumes no responsibility for any medical expenses incurred after the sale.
13. The breeder assumes no responsibility for training difficulties or behavior problems. Buyer will receive information pertaining to training their new puppy upon receipt of their puppy. If the buyer is struggling with training or behavior problems, they are encouraged to reach out to the breeder for advice and support while understanding the breeder may not have a solution to their problem, but will do all they can within their power to help and support transitioning.
14. The breeder does not guarantee fertility or ability to place in shows. This puppy is strictly sold as a **FAMILY PET**.
15. The buyer agrees to spay or neuter their pet before 1 year of age unless stated for medical reasons by a licensed veterinarian in writing. The buyer should aim to spay or neuter their pet between 6-8 months old. The buyer understands their pet may **NOT** be used for breeding and in doing so will result in a \$25,000 fine per litter produced that the buyer agrees to pay the breeder within 30 calendar days of the litter being born.
16. The breeder gives a 3 year guarantee against any birth defects of the puppy. If there are any defects found before the puppy's 3rd birthday, the buyer may choose to return the puppy and receive another puppy of the same breed when one becomes available. In order to honor this, the buyer understands that the puppy will need to be examined for these genetic issues by the breeder's veterinarian at the expense of the buyer. Some examples of genetic issues covered by this guarantee are hip dysplasia, cataracts, cleft palate, and defects of the sort. If the dog dies, a necropsy at the expense of the buyer must be had to show the cause of death. The Breeder will replace the dog with a new dog as soon as one becomes available. No monetary exchanges will occur in the manner of a refund of the original purchase price or travel costs or other vaccinations that may have come with the original puppy.
17. If there are any disagreements or if either party feels that this contract is not upheld to the highest extent that is expected for the best interest of the puppy/dog, both parties agree to first try Arbitration in

Williamson County, Texas before proceeding legally in a court of law. Both parties agree to pay for their own legal fees unless agreed upon in arbitration or ordered in a court of law.

18. If for any reason I am unable to keep the puppy, I agree to contact Bluebonnet Pomsies before placing the puppy in another home or being taken to a shelter. The buyer understands that Bluebonnet Pomsies reserves the right to have first right of refusal if an adequate home can not be found, to which foster care and/or a shelter includes as “an inadequate home.” If the puppy is returned within **30 days**, only half of the purchase price will be refunded once the puppy is successfully placed in a new home. If the puppy is returned after 30 days, no refund will be available. All expenses for returning the puppy to Bluebonnet Pomsies will be at the expense of the buyer. Bluebonnet Pomsies is a kennel owned and operated under Hero’s Ranch, LLC.
