Call To Order – President Lynn Burrows called the meeting to order at 7:59 and Florice Lietzke read a prayer.

Approval of 10/21/2025 Meeting Minutes The minutes were approved.

Business Meeting: Middle Park Health Updates

Middle Park Health Jason Klecker spoke first and reported on new equipment and programs. They have a new 3d mammography unit. There is a partnership with Steamboat Orthopedic to offer extended services in Granby and Kremmling. This includes something called a swing bed program which is a type of rehab program that allows patients who no longer require acute care, but still need skilled services to recover in a local hospital.

Jason introduced general surgeon Dr. Matt Fabian who most recently is from North Dakota and Iowa (he grew up in Fargo).

Next was Andy Radzavic Middle Park Health Foundation Executive Director. He reported on happenings at the new Emergency unit at Fraser. From June - September the unit saw 570 patients and 6 flights for life.

The fundraising campaigns for the campus yielded \$2.2 million and a portion of those funds also supported services in other areas such as a new CT scanner and the Mamography machine.

He also reported that the Cooper Creek clinic is still functional.

Finally, case manager Bethany Reynolds spoke a bit more about the swing bed program. This program is helpful for extended care here in Grand County as there is no home health service. They can house 5 to 10 patients at the Kremmling hospital at a lower level of care (not acute) but still skilled care or long term
