

PUBLIC HEARING on a Community Development Building Grant was held on Monday, August 22, 2011, at 6:45 p.m. in Council Chambers at 82 Main St., Hornell, N.Y.

PRESENT: Honorable Shawn D. Hogan, Mayor; Aldermen Angelo Sciotti, Joe Testani, Chris Koehler, Bob Murray, Bob Lockwood, Angelo Sciotti, John Buckley and City Clerk Barbara M. Perrott.

AND FROM THE MEDIA: Andrew Poole of The Evening Tribune and Brian O'Neil of WLEA.

ALSO PRESENT: Todd & Michele Smith and Randy Harkenrider.

Mayor Hogan opened the hearing by explaining that TTA plans expansion at the Jackson Blvd. location, in the machinery and tooling section. They will be working with different transit systems through out the country.

With the expansion, TTA anticipated 30 new jobs within the next two years. At least 51 percent of the added employees need to be considered low-to-moderate income prior to being hired.

One half of the money is a direct grant, with the other half being a low interest loan to be repaid over a ten year period. The city will administer the grant and will receive \$10,000 to meet administrative costs.

The state is expected to reach a decision on the application in September.

There being no further comment, the public hearing was closed at 6:54 p.m.
