This CoC applies, in extension to the conference CoC documented at <https://pyconf.hydp.org/2022/code-of-conduct> specifically to the Community Partners with regards to what they should and shouldn't do at the expo booths.

1. Use inclusive language at all times while addressing a single person or a group
2. Have an open communication and avoid any comments / remarks based on other person(s) ethnicity
3. Avoid any derogatory and/or discriminatory content while presenting at the booths
4. Don't assume and be clear in your communication when presenting or expressing thoughts or engaging the audience at the booth
5. Avoid running any kind of sessions or event at the booth during keynote / opening / closing / lightning talks at the main stage
6. Refrain from any promotions for any paid / professional content and it should only revolve around Python and Open Source Software
