2–4 Months Before Your Move

- ☐ Begin actively viewing homes (in-person or virtually)
- ☐ Work with your agent to make competitive offers
- ☐ Secure a moving company or plan your move logistics
- ☐ Notify your employer and begin planning time off

Month Before Your Move

- ☐ Finalize closing and secure homeowner's insurance
- ☐ Change your address with USPS and key accounts
- ☐ Transfer or set up utilities in Atlanta
- ☐ Schedule home inspection, appraisal, and final walkthrough

Move Week

- ☐ Pack essentials and label moving boxes clearly
- ☐ Confirm move-in date and logistics with your agent
- ☐ Conduct final walkthrough and closing
