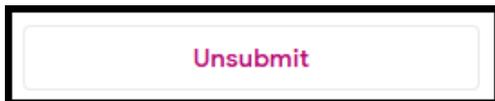


Google Classroom: Unsubmit and Resubmit Assignments

After you Turn In your work in a Google Classroom assignment, you may see the following buttons:



or



UNSUBMIT

When you TURN IN an assignment with a document attached, the document will now be in possession of your teacher just like if you handed your teacher a physical copy of the assignment. You will NOT be able to edit the document until the teacher RETURNS the assignment to you or you UNSUBMIT the assignment.

Please be aware that Classroom does put a timestamp for EVERY action that you do. So, teachers WILL see when you first submitted the assignment and when you UNSUBMIT an assignment.

Please consult your teacher's policy regarding late or resubmitted work.

When you unsubmit the assignment, you now have the document in your Google Drive and can edit the document. Again, note that your teacher will know when you unsubmitted an assignment and will also know when you made any edits to the document, as well as, what edits you made.

If you choose to UNSUBMIT an assignment, Google Classroom will change the status of your assignment to MISSING. The teacher will be able to see when you unsubmitted your assignment and will also be able to see what changes you made in the document. Don't forget to TURN IN the assignment and document before the due date (if any) so that it does not become late. Google Classroom will make your assignment LATE if you do not turn in your assignment by the due date posted in Google Classroom.

After you have completed any changes, you can now TURN IN this assignment.



RESUBMIT

When your teacher is done reviewing your assignment, they will RETURN your assignment to you. This is just like when your teacher gives you back the physical copy of an assignment that you turned in during class.

Google Classroom allows you to RESUBMIT the assignment after your teacher has returned it to you.

Any policy or decision regarding resubmitted work is solely at the discretion of your teacher.
