Dear Lincoln Community,

California High Schools must provide a minimum of 64,800 instructional minutes and 180 instructional days annually. During the 2016-2017 School Year, Lincoln planned to offer 65,277 annual instructional minutes. Due to revisions made part-way through the year to the school's bell schedule, however, three school days did not qualify for instructional minutes (although the school was open).

As a result, ALHS was penalized for insufficient instructional days and minutes.

After careful review and consideration, the State is mandating corrective action. For school years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022, the school site will add an additional 3 days to their instructional calendar as follows:

- **SY 2020-2021 - Year 1 Completed**
 - November 23, 2020
 - November 24, 2020
 - November 25, 2020

- **SY 2021-2022**
 - November 22, 2021
 - November 23, 2021
 - November 24, 2021

Students are expected to participate in their regularly scheduled classes on these days: **Monday, November 22 is a regular school day from 8:40 am-3:55 pm; Tuesday, November 23rd is block day with 2nd, 4th, and 6th periods; Wednesday, November 24 is a block day with 1st, 3rd, and 5th periods.** On Wednesday, our ASB is sponsoring "Mustang Exchange Day", more information to follow.

We understand this may come as a surprise and impact some of your holiday travel plans, but unfortunately, **this is a state mandate.**
