Services of the DSW Office, IGU Meerpur

The **Dean Students' Welfare (DSW) Office** at Indira Gandhi University (IGU), Meerpur plays a vital role in enhancing the student experience by providing a variety of support services and extracurricular opportunities. These services aim at holistic development, welfare, and active engagement of students across the University Teaching Departments (UTDs) and affiliated colleges. Below are the key services offered by the DSW Office:

1. Organization of Annual Youth Festivals

One of the flagship activities of the DSW Office is organizing annual Youth Festivals at both Zonal and Inter-Zonal levels. The Zonal-level festivals are conducted across two different zones—Rewari Zone and Mahendergarh Zone—providing a platform for students to showcase their talents in music, dance, drama, fine arts, and literature. The top four performing teams from each zone qualify for the Inter-Zonal/University-Level Youth Festival, popularly known as "Hindola". These events foster a spirit of healthy competition and cultural harmony among students.

2. Provision of Bus Pass Facility

The DSW Office facilitates **bus passes** for a large number of students to ensure smooth and affordable travel between their homes and the University. This involves a streamlined process that includes **cash collection**, **deposit**, **preparation**, **and distribution** of bus passes. This service significantly reduces transportation challenges for students and supports their regular attendance and participation in academic activities.

3. Providing Financial Aid to Students

Financial support is extended to **needy and physically challenged students** through a structured process led by the DSW Office. After carefully **assessing and verifying** the financial status and requirements of students, the DSW Office recommends eligible cases to the **Vice-Chancellor** for approval. This initiative ensures that no student is deprived of education due to financial constraints.

4. Earn While You Learn Scheme

The **Earn While You Learn** scheme provides opportunities for students to engage in part-time, on-campus work, allowing them to **earn while continuing their education**. This not only supports students financially but also helps them develop practical skills, work ethics, and a sense of responsibility. The scheme is especially beneficial for economically weaker sections of the student community.

5. Organization of Camps and Personality Development Programs

To promote leadership, resilience, and personal growth, the DSW Office organizes various student-centric camps such as:

- Adventure Camps
- Youth Leadership Camps
- Personality Development Camps

These are conducted for students from both University Teaching Departments (UTDs) and affiliated colleges/institutions. The camps are designed to enhance students' team spirit, self-confidence, and overall personality.

6. Students' Clubs and Societies

The DSW Office actively supports and manages a range of **student clubs**, providing students with platforms to explore their talents and interests. These include:

- Dance Club
- Music Club
- Theatre Club
- Fine Arts Club
- Literary Club
- Photography Club and many more

These clubs conduct regular workshops, performances, and competitions that help students nurture their creative skills and engage with like-minded peers.

7. Funding of Educational and Cultural Tours

Students are encouraged to participate in **educational and cultural tours** to places of historical, academic, and cultural importance. These tours are structured to:

- Develop leadership qualities
- Encourage team building
- Foster human values and a respect for cultural diversity

The **DSW Office funds up to 50%** of the total expenditure for these tours, making them accessible to students from all backgrounds.

8. Organization of Cultural Activities and University Events

The DSW Office organizes several large-scale cultural events and institutional celebrations, including:

- Annual Function
- Foundation Day
- Diwali Fest
- Various Youth Cultural Programs
- Celebrations of National Fest like Republic Day, Independence Day etc

A detailed **Calendar of Activities** is released each academic year, outlining all planned events. These programs enrich the university's cultural environment and provide students with a vibrant and inclusive campus life. Under the **leadership and guidance of the Dean Students' Welfare**, the department remains committed to nurturing talent and encouraging student participation in cultural life.
