Court System

Update from Norman and Archie,

- Warrants** for raids can be requested by Police / NCA and approved by one of the three new judges.
- Appeals** - It was also decided that rather than pre-sentence trials, individuals will be able to appeal their sentences and claim compensation (to avoid everyone trying to delay their sentence by having a trial).
- Solicitors** can sign up and be vetted by judges, they are then awarded a License the police can check. This can be revoked if they commit crimes or are no longer suitable. **@Fluqi** to talk to judges about vetting

MEMBER'S BUSINESS TO RAISE

NHS Giving out locations

Phoenix raised the question of the NHS giving identifying crime and giving that information to the police.

- Council **agreed** that NHS should be working with police
- Council **agreed** that a method of injured people choosing to 'Request NHS' should be looked into - so that locations aren't automatically given away @Archie @Phoenix

Limit employees at car dealerships

Fluqi and Antolymme brought forward the fact that many dealerships have 4-5 employees, with nearly 20-25 employees at car dealerships. After much discussion around who should be working at a car dealership.

- Council **voted** to limit workers to being *owner + three employees* @Archie @DanB @Norman to implement both technically and also inform dealers
- Council **agreed** to postpone any decisions about who should be eligible to work at a dealership. Stealthee advised that owners should speak to their employees about time dedication and look at potential financial incentives to have less employees @Stealthee @Archie @DanB

Quality of Faction Roleplay

Antolymme raised an issue with NHS behaviour he had experienced.

- Stealthee told to send to NHS Command or IOPC - not appropriate for council @Antolymme @Phoenix

PROPOSALS BROUGHT FORWARD

Office for Legal Justice Group

Kseniya has asked for an office in the city hall

- Council **agreed** that any solicitor group can claim offices in that building, no specific development measures will be put in place to ring-fence them for specific groups at this point in time.
