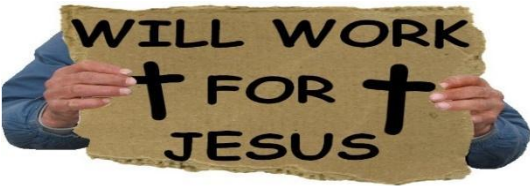

WORKING FOR JESUS!

Jesus said: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my

burden is light."

(Matthew 11:28-30)

Labor/Work! Some people hate to do it. Some love to do it. Some go to great lengths to avoid doing it. Some do it too much. While there are many different attitudes toward labor/work, one thing remains constant: work must be done. Since God's creation of the Garden of Eden and humankind, everyone has worked or depended on someone else's work for their survival. Work determines a person's lifestyle...where you live, when you sleep and eat, the time with family, even your spiritual life.

Work Is Ordained By God. It was His creative development from the beginning of time. The Bible declares that God worked (Genesis 1). Think of it this way, by working we resemble God. Like God, most individuals have the ability to work, make plans, implement them, and be creative. Additionally, God gave us the task of ruling over and taking care of all His creation (Genesis 1:28, Genesis 2:15).

Work Is For A Lifetime. "By the sweat of your face you shall eat bread, till you return to the ground". (Genesis 3:19). God intends that humans, which are capable, are to work as long as they live. Meaningful activity plays a critical role in being a human being - whether paid or volunteer. The magical age of 65 shouldn't end meaningful, purposeful ways of doing God's work. Granted there comes a time we no longer do physical labor but God's work is never done. Sharing the good news of life eternal should always be a part of everyone's work ethic...be you young or old.

Work Is Not A Punishment. God did not create work as drudgery, but as a gift of fulfillment to life. A lot depends on how one approaches and perceives work. Christ's work of saving souls has never ended and so it is with each of us. "A human being *can do nothing better than...find satisfaction in his work. This too, I see, is from the hand of God, for without Him, who can eat or find enjoyment*"? (Ecclesiastes 2:24-25)

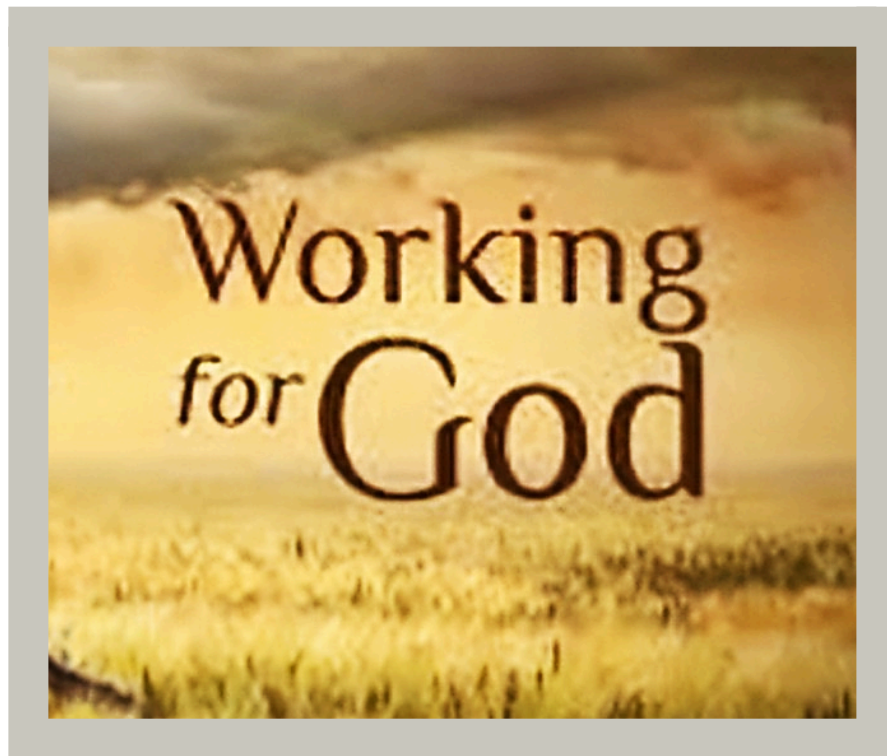
All vocations and all kinds of work, assuming they are legal and biblically ethical, must be honorable before the Lord. If the work you do is moral, decent and worthy then there should be no separation between sacred and secular work...it all depends on how you perform. Remember, all work brings glory to God and fulfillment to you, if it is done to God's glory . **"So, whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."** (1 Corinthians 10:31).
