## Student's Name:

**Standard:** Write informative/explanatory texts to examine and convey complex ideas and information clearly and accurately through the effective selection, organization, and analysis of content.

**Objective:** Students will locate information, organize details, and create structure for a one-page paper about financial literacy and how financial literacy is important to financial success; they will also create a multimedia presentation that supports their research.

**Essential Questions:** What is one important concept that I need to understand in order to help secure my future financial success? How can I demonstrate what I learned in a multimedia project/presentation?
