1. INTRODUCTION

The introduction should explain the phenomenon that underpins the research and establish the main topic of the study. The author should summarize and cite previous research relevant to the current study and highlight the knowledge gaps that this research can address. The introduction should clearly state the research question and outline the author's hypotheses.

2. METHODS

This section contains a brief explanation of the research design, variable identification, research subjects, data collection techniques, research instruments (name of measuring instrument and its manufacturer, aspects measured, number of items, and several examples, as well as validity and reliability information), research instrument procedures, and statistical analysis techniques used. The explanation in this section focuses on clear descriptive explanations of the various activities carried out by the researcher in conducting the research, so that it can provide an opportunity for other researchers to replicate or verify the research procedures carried out. Avoid including definitions regarding parts of the method, for example: definition, population, and others.

3. RESULTS

Research results consist of a description of the data obtained during the study. 4. DISCUSSION

The discussion section provides a description of the researcher's analysis of the research findings, linking them to previous research findings. This section focuses on a critical and substantive analysis of the research findings and comparisons with previous findings based on a review of relevant, current, and primary literature. Comparisons should highlight differences with previous research findings, demonstrating the research's contribution to the development of scientific knowledge. The final section presents the limitations of the research. The discussion should be a minimum of 30% of the total number of pages, which should not be shorter than the introduction.

The research results section is presented first, followed by the discussion section (with or without subheadings).

5. CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

The conclusion section formulates answers to the research objectives and research questions. The conclusion is not a summary of the research results. When explaining the conclusion, it should be concise, clear, and concise, based on the results and discussion, and should be presented in paragraph form, not numerically. The conclusion explains the research findings and new developments that contribute to the development of psychology. Recommendations based on the findings are addressed to specific parties, with operational suggestions presented in short paragraphs




Figure 1. Sociocultural disharmony in the form of poverty and mental health issues
