Foster Middle School Uniform Policy 2024-2025

Policy and Procedure:

Students must adhere to Foster Middle School's *Uniform Policy*. <u>Final decision on the appropriateness of dress rests with the campus administration</u>. Students violating the dress code will be subject to disciplinary action.

Guidelines:

1) Pants and Slacks



- a) Navy, Black, Gray or Khaki (Docker style fabric, <u>No</u>
 <u>Joggers.</u>)
- b) No skin-tight/stretch pants (ex. Jeggings/ Leggings, Yoga pants.)
- c) Must be worn at the waist.


2) Shorts/Skirts/Jumpers

- a) Navy, Black, Gray or Khaki
- b) Must be worn at the waist.



- c) No shorter than three inches above the top of the knee.
- d) Tennis skirts are not allowed.

3) Tops (Polo Style)





- b) Can be short or long-sleeved (no sleeveless shirts).
- c) Shirts must be tucked in (Exception: sweatshirts).

4) Outerwear/Coats



- a) Acceptable outwear: Coats, Jackets, Half-Zips, Hoodies, Sweatshirts, and Sweaters.
- b) Hoods may **not** be worn in the building.
- c) <u>School shirts **MUST** be</u> visible under all outerwear.


5) No Headwear

6) Belts



a) Threaded through all belt loops and end tucked in.

7) Socks & Shoes





- b) Shoes must be closed toe with backing.
- c) No Crocs, Clogs, or Flip Flops

8) Identification Badge (ID)



- a) IDs must be worn around the neck <u>At All Times</u>, using a lanyard or clip.
- b) Must not be damaged or defaced.
- c) First ID is Free (Replacements cost \$3.00)
- **9) Spirit Days** (Uniform pants must be worn.)



 a) Tuesdays- FMS Spirit or Club/Organization shirt Wednesdays- College Shirt

Thursdays- House Shirts **Fridays-** FMS or Lobo, spirit shirt. Jeans **ONLY** at principal's discretion.
