

# **Cleveland Archaeological Society - Field School Scholarship**

## **Example Budgets**

**Please Note:** Figures are for illustrative purposes only. Actual amounts will vary.

### **Example A:**

If you plan on attending an overseas field school, your budget might include the following items:

Airfare (Cleveland to Athens, Greece): \$1,200

Field School Fee (includes housing and meals from Monday to Friday): \$3,800

Weekend Meals (8 days): \$200

Total Expenses: \$5,200

### **Example B:**

If you plan on attending a local field school, you might include rent if you would normally work full-time during the summer and need to take time off to attend the excavation:

Tuition and Fees: \$3,300

Required Equipment (trowel, boots, metric tape, line level, work gloves, journal): \$180

Rent (one month, I won't be able to work during the field school): \$1,000

Total Expenses: \$4,480

### **Example C:**

If you plan on attending a domestic field school, but located out of state and outdoors, your budget might include:

Tuition and Fees: \$3,800

Airfare (Cleveland to Tucson, AZ): \$400

Required Equipment (tent, trowel, tapes, journal, sleeping bag, camping supplies): \$700

Total Expenses: \$4,900
