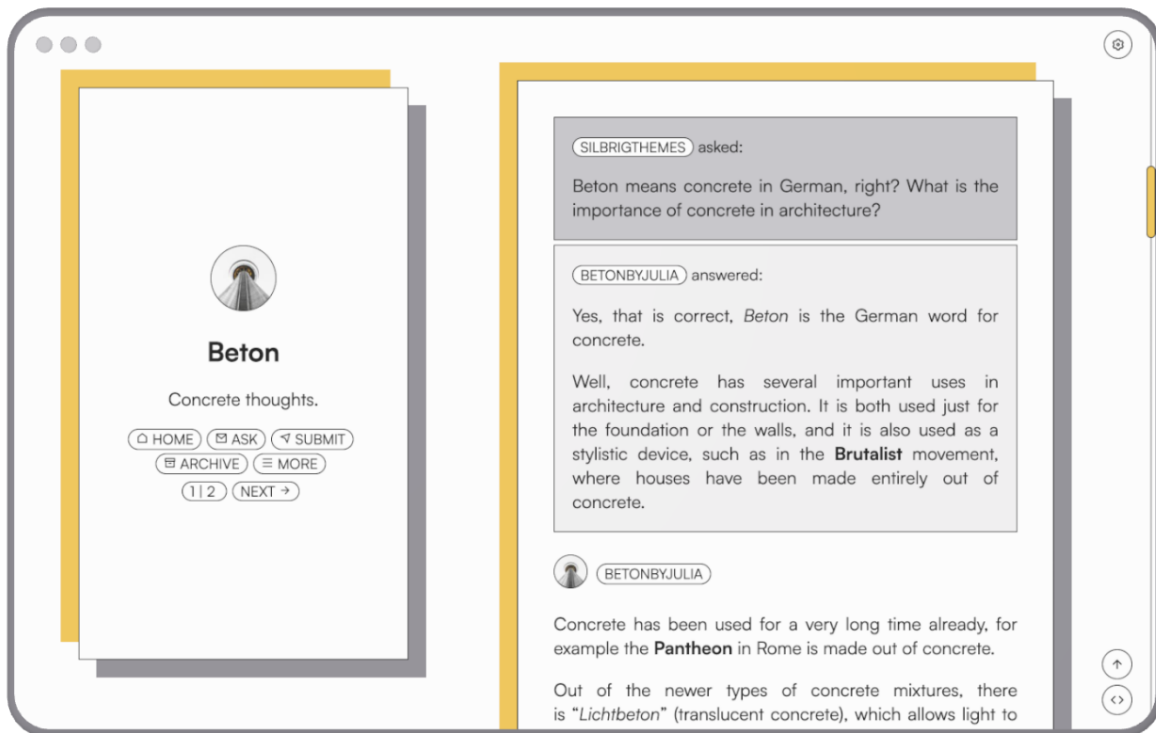

- Different text transformation options for
 - Buttons: Links in the sidebar, post information, etc.
 - Navlinks: Links in the mobile dropdown navigation.
 - Tooltips.
- Rounded element accents (optional).

3. Customization

3.1 General Information

If you run into any issues while trying to customize this theme, please take the time to read the information and help presented in this customization guide first. I will try to explain some basics here, so the customization process is easier for you.

Additionally, before you come to my inbox asking about something, try to do the following things first:

- Read this customization guide.
- Read through the support or answered tag on my blog.
- Try to google the issue – w3schools, stackoverflow and others often have an answer.

If none of that helped you resolve the issue, send me a message via my inbox or the tumblr direct messenger.

Here is some basic etiquette because otherwise I either cannot or do not want to help you:

- Have patience – my life is busy and tumblr is not my job.
- Be nice – if you insult me, I will just block you.
- Come o anon if you send a question through the inbox.
- Please tell me what problem is occurring, where it is occurring, and ideally also which one of my codes you're using – the more information, the easier it is for me to help you, resulting in a faster answer.

3.2 Colors

There are 7 (seven) color options in the customization panel. The table below gives you a quick overview over their purposes.

Nr.	Name	Purpose
1	Accent A	<u>Background</u> : Scrollbar thumb, tooltips, marked text. <u>Hover BG</u> : Read more, GIF attribution, sidebar links, link posts, usernames, post information, more notes, controls, mobile dropdown links. <u>Box Shadow</u> : Sidebar, posts.
2	Accent B	<u>Background</u> : Mobile toolbar, lightbox. <u>Border</u> : Search on focus. <u>Box Shadow</u> : Sidebar, posts. <u>Text</u> : Links, hover search, even chat names, deactivated users.
3	Background	<u>Background</u> : Audio posts, body, scrollbar, read more, GIF attribution, text line hr, sidebar, sidebar links, sidebar overlay, posts, link posts, usernames, post information, more notes, controls. <u>Border</u> : Scrollbar, scrollbar thumb.
4	Borders	<u>Border</u> : Scrollbar, scrollbar thumb, tooltips, blockquote, images, iframes, figures, read more, GIF attribution, text line hr, sidebar, blog icon, sidebar links, posts, link posts, questions, answers, usernames, post information, more notes, controls, footer, mobile dropdown, sidebar overlay.
5	Preformatted ¹	<u>Background</u> : Audio posts, preformatted text, read more, GIF attribution, sidebar links, link posts, usernames, post information, more notes, controls, mobile footer, mobile dropdown.
6	Selection	Text selection background.
7	Text	<u>Text Color</u> : Audio posts, body, text selection, tooltips, hover links, marked text, preformatted text, read more, GIF attribution, sidebar links, search, odd chat names, link posts, questions, answers, usernames, post information, more notes, controls, mobile footer, footer links, mobile dropdown links.

¹ In most cases, *Preformatted* only goes into effect as the background color if borders are disabled. This is necessary in order to keep enough contrast between elements.

3.3 Selectors

There are 11 (eleven) selectors in the customization panel which allow you to select a style from a given list of options. The table below gives you an overview over their purposes.

1	Post Width	Width of posts.	5
2	Font Size	Global font size.	5
3	Font	Global font.	12
4	Code Font	Font for preformatted text.	6
5	Text Align	Global text alignment.	2
6	Title Align	Alignment of post titles and quotes.	3
7	Ordered List	Item markers of ordered lists.	5
8	Unordered List	Item markers of unordered lists.	3
9	Button Transform	Text transformation of sidebar links, post information links, etc.	4
10	Navlink Transform	Text transformation of links in the mobile dropdown.	4
11	Tooltip Transform	Text transformation of tooltips.	4

3.4 Toggles

There are 16 (sixteen) toggles³ in the customization panel which allow you to enable or disable a style or an element altogether. The table below aims to give you an overview over their purposes.

Nr.	Name	Purpose	Default
1	Show Captions	Show or hide captions on the home page.	Inactive
2	Show Tags	Show or hide tags on the home page.	Active
3	Show Search	Show or hide the search in the sidebar overlay.	Active
4	Show Update	Show or hide the update section in the sidebar overlay.	Active
5	Post Shadows	Enable or disable box shadows on posts and the sidebar.	Active
6	Borders	Enable or disable borders on all elements that are not images, figures or iframes.	Active
7	Image Borders	Enable or disable borders on all images, figures and iframes.	Active
8	Rounded Accents	Enable or disable rounded borders for certain elements, e.g. icons and tags.	Active
9	Disable Italics	Display italicized text as slanted or force text to be displayed as straight.	Inactive
10	Sans Serif Only	Display all fonts as they are or override them with the font chosen under Font .	Inactive
11	No Colored Text	Display tumblr's colored text as it is or override it with the color Text .	Inactive
12	Show Link N	Show or hide the custom links in the sidebar overlay and the mobile dropdown.	Active

³ Active toggles are **blue**, inactive toggles are **gray**. Tumblr inverts these colors when you first install a theme, meaning that a toggle might be shown as inactive while the element is visible.

3.5 Text Fields

There are 13 (thirteen) text fields in the customization panel which allow you to assign a very specific value to an element. The table below aims to give you an overview over their purposes.

Nr.	Name	Purpose
1	Photoset Gap	Gap between the individual images of a photoset. Enter a value in pixels, e.g. 4px.
2	Lightbox Opacity	Opacity of the lightbox background. Enter a value between 0 and 1 or 0% and 100%. 0 = transparent, $0 < x < 1$ or $0 < x < 100\%$ = opaque background, 1 or 100% = solid background
3	Update ⁴	Enter some text for the update you would like to display. Keeping it short looks best but the box scrolls if you add more text, so you should not worry about the length too much.
4	Link N ⁵	Name of a custom link, e.g. About Me.
5	URL N	URL of a custom link, e.g. /about or https://name.carrd.co/

⁴ Only visible if the toggle **Show Update** is enabled.

⁵ Only visible if the corresponding toggle **Show Link N** is enabled.

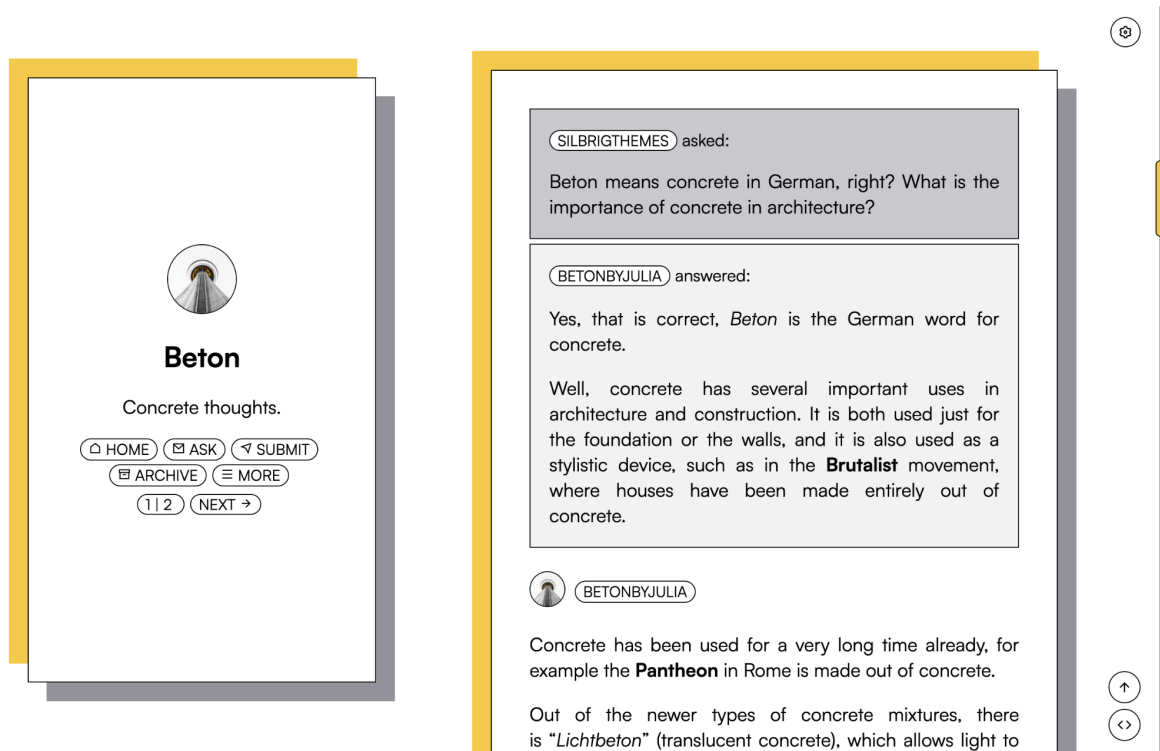


Fig. 1: Desktop view with enabled borders and post shadows.

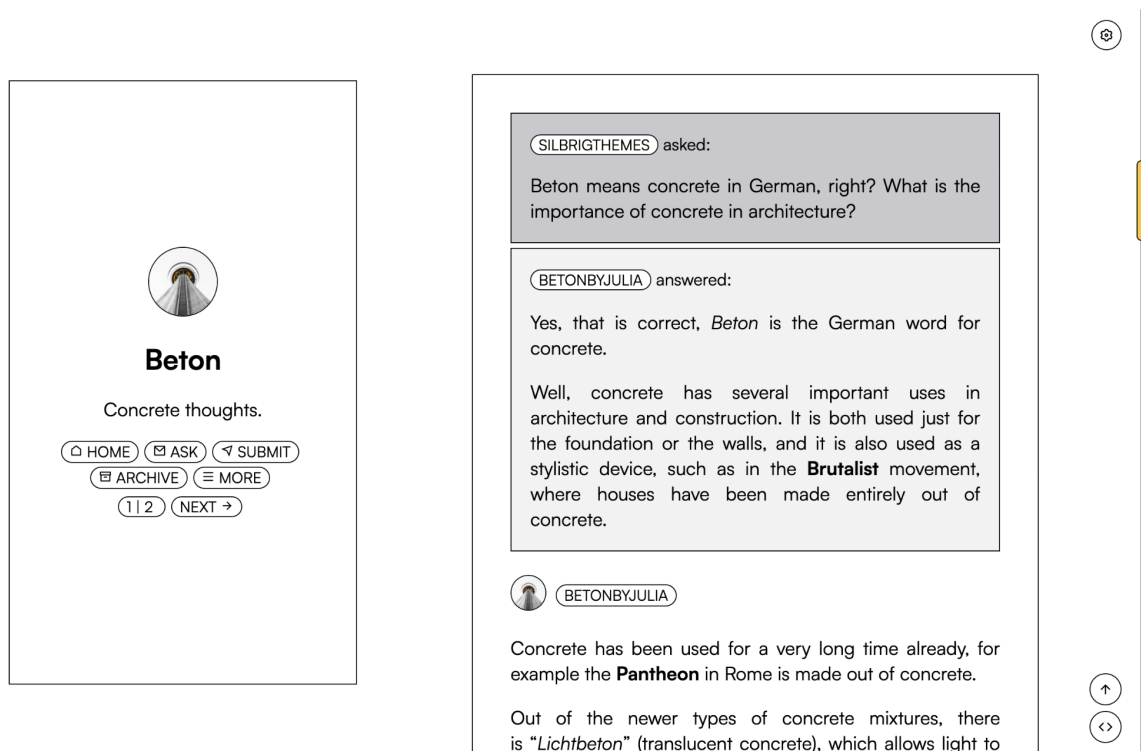
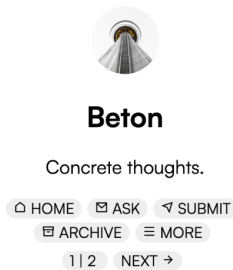


Fig. 2: Desktop view with borders enabled and post shadows disabled.

Fig. 3: Desktop view with borders and post shadows disabled.

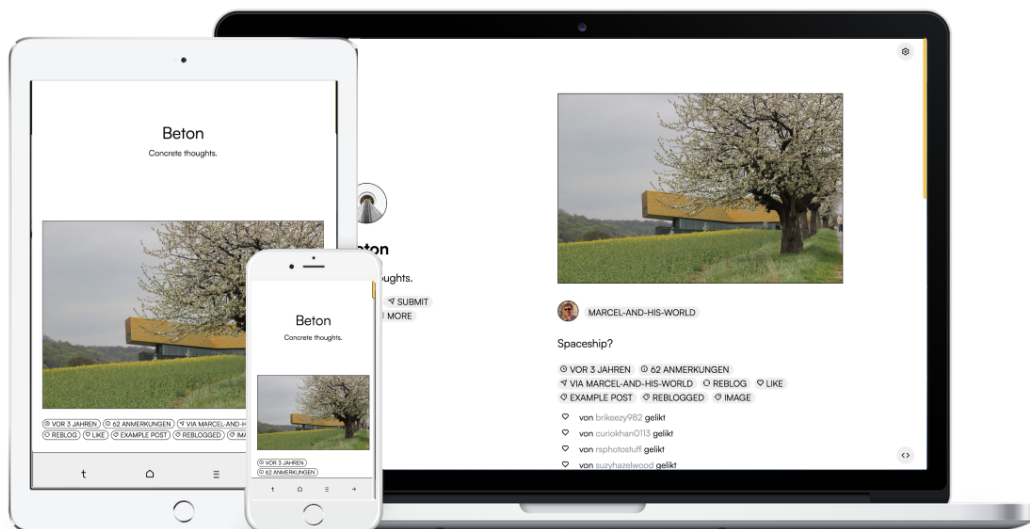


Fig. 4: Responsive view.

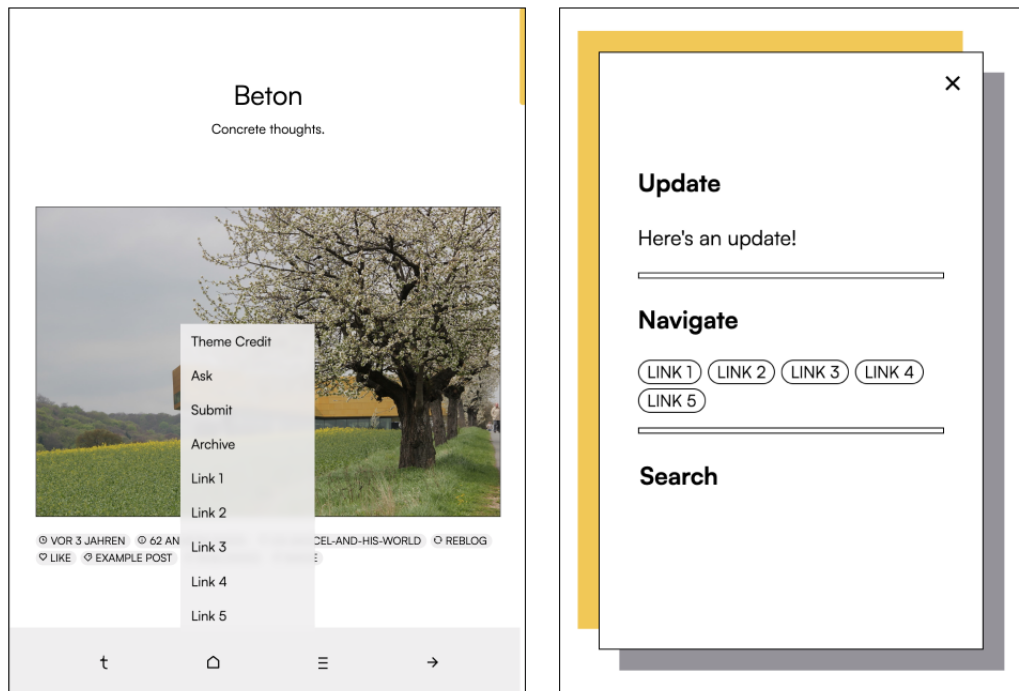


Fig. 5: Opened mobile dropdown navigation (left) and opened sidebar overlay (right).
