Designed for the most motivated and ambitious players competing at the highest levels. Players commit to an elite practice environment, individual skills development, and travel to high-level events across Southern California and select out-of-state events.

A / BB / B

The foundation of competitive club hockey — ideal for players focused on structured growth and development. Players commit to an elite practice environment and compete in local Southern California league games and tournaments.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP FEES — WHAT'S INCLUDED

On-Ice Practices

- 8U A & B, 10U BB, 12U B: 2 shared on-ice practices per week
- 10U A, 12U BB, 14U A: 1 full-ice and 1 shared on-ice practice per week
- AA Tier II Teams: 2 full-sheet practices per week (coaches may work together with other Tier II teams to share ice and create more touches in their evaluation of best team planning)
- Off-ice programming: may include strength & conditioning, team video sessions, and team bonding, based on head coach's direction

League Games

Approximately 15–16 SCAHA local league games per season.

Annual League Membership

SCAHA/CAHA team and player membership fees for the full season.

No-Practice Blackout Dates

Built into your fees — no prorations or credits apply for blackout dates.

- Blackout Weekends: Labor Day, MLK

- Full Blackout Weeks: Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Year's, President's Day

TOURNAMENT & TEAM EVENTS PACKAGE — WHAT'S INCLUDED

All events listed below are pre-planned and fixed, packaged into your total seasonal fees. The Club registers all teams directly into these events in coordination with each head coach. Specific local tournament options may vary (e.g. California Dreamin', Tinseltown, The Rinks events, or select out-of-state options) but the scheduled tournament weekend is fixed. These events will not be added to your bill separately or variably.

A / BB / B Teams — Events Schedule

AA Tier II Teams & 10UA — Events Schedule

- Summer Pre-Season Prep Program — Local practices & scrimmage games (Late July–Mid August)
- Labor Day Tournament — Local/SoCal
- Thanksgiving Tournament — Local/SoCal
- Winter Holiday Training Camp & Scrimmages — Local/SoCal
- MLK Weekend Tournament — Local/SoCal
- President's Day Tournament — Travel Tournament Out of State (TBA)
- *Note: With prior Club President approval, the head coach may elect to schedule the out-of-state event on MLK Weekend instead of President's Day Weekend.*
- **AA teams moving down to A levels, or select A level teams, may — with Club President approval — elect to participate in an out-of-state event similar to the AA team events schedule.*

**Specific tournament selections may vary by local availability (e.g. California Dreamin', Tinseltown, The Rinks events, or select out-of-state options). The Club registers teams directly in coordination with the head coach. The scheduled tournament weekends are fixed.*

OPTIONAL ADDITIONAL TRAVEL — AA TIER II TEAMS & SELECT A LEVEL TEAMS (NOT INCLUDED IN PACKAGE)

**And select 'A' level teams with prior Club President approval.*

AA coaches — and select A level team coaches with prior written Club President approval — may organize additional travel events beyond the fixed Tournament & Team Events Package. These optional events are strictly voluntary and NOT included in Club Membership Fees or the Tournament & Team Events Package. No player or family may be required to participate or pay for these events. They are organized and collected separately at the team level, with all expenses tracked, accounted for, and audited by the club treasurer. Any surplus funds at season end must be returned to participating families or donated to the Quest Foundation — they may not be carried over or retained.

Examples of optional additional events:

- Late August scrimmage series (e.g., Arizona, Nevada)
- October/November trip (e.g., Veterans Day CCM Invite, Dallas CCM)
- December blackout week travel (e.g., Las Vegas Christmas Tournament)

**SCAHA Bye requests are required for additional weekend travel. Teams may not miss league games.*

NOT INCLUDED IN CLUB MEMBERSHIP FEES OR EVENTS PACKAGE

1. CAHA State Competition weekends — assessed separately as your team advances in state play
2. Post-season playoff games, practices, and coaching fees
3. Team uniforms and apparel (ordered separately)
4. Player travel, lodging, and personal expenses to all events
5. Spring, summer, and private training programs
6. Small group or private lessons and specialty clinics
7. Optional summer program events (e.g., Monarchy Tournament Teams)
8. Additional games or training added beyond the original plan — communicated and agreed upon with families in advance

CAHA STATE COMPETITION

CAHA weekends are NOT included in your fees. Only teams that advance beyond SCAHA play will have additional CAHA games and weekends. Costs are calculated and communicated as your team advances.

- We project one CAHA weekend for 14U or 16U AA teams advancing to State play
- An additional weekend may apply if the team advances to State Playdowns

APPROXIMATE SEASON GAME TOTALS

Approx. 15–16 SCAHA league games + 16–20 tournament games & scrimmages = 30–35 total games minimum, before any playoffs or CAHA State play.

MANDATORY FUNDRAISER PARTICIPATION

9. Player Fundraiser — Funds raised can be applied toward your Club Membership Fees, Tournament & Team Events fees, and/or training programs, while also supporting the Quest Foundation (501c3).
