GENERAL PART NOTES FOR THIS PART TYPE

Bootlid - Vehicles that are classified as sedans/coupes have bootlids Tailgates - Vehicles that are classified as hatchbacks/vans/utes/station wagons have tailgates

BOOTLID - SEE SEPARATE LINK FOR IMAGES

TAILGATE - SEE SEPARATE LINK FOR IMAGES

Also called; Bootlid - Trunk lid, Boot Tailgate - Hatch, gate

Components that will always be included with this item(if they are not with Part or damaged, it should be noted in description) Bootlid/Tailgate shell

Components may be available at no charge i.e usually just left on Part but not charged extra for (if buyer requests these items make sure to confirm with operations that they are with the Part)

- Boot/gate lock assembly
- Glass (tailgate)
- Rear Garnish
- Handle
- Spoiler (if spoilered type)
- Wiper motor (tailgate)

All of the above mentioned parts are sub assembly items, sometimes these parts are sold separately, to check whether sub-assembly items are available see FAQ below.

Components not included usually but which maybe included at extra charge i.e not usually with part but we will have if required (if buyer requests these items make sure to confirm with operations that they are with the part)

- Bootlid hinges

-spare wheel ,spare wheel cover or carrier

what fails with this part type ,what to look for

- Previous repairs (P/R)

- Dents (noted on pinnacle comments)

- if car has spare wheel and spare wheel is pushed in ,it easily bends tailgate but this cant be seen as damaged is located under tailgate

- Rust

What are the variables for this part type i.e km reading ,color for panels

- If private non trade purchase may have to match color. Generally for trade users this is not an issue as trade user will expect to have to paint this

- Spoiler or non spoilered type

Spoiler types have holes drilled to mount spoiler.

- Keyhole type or non keyhole type

Keyhole types have a key lock provision on the tailgate/bootlid

When quoting assemblies (i.e doors or tailgates) you build the assembly up , down work down.

Don't quote as complete boot/tailgate less glass or lock.

IE TAILGATE WITH GLASS if the customer wants the tailgate with glass. Then we quote the tailgate shell and tailgate glass separate

Ie BOOT/TAILGATE WITH LOCK locks maybe central locking or non central locking , even though door is same We quote the boot/tailgate and lock separate

Ie. COMPLETE BOOT/TAILGATE We quote the boot/tailgate shell and all of its sub-assemblies separate

FAQ- SPECIFIC FOR THIS PART - COMMON ISSUES

Do we include hinges with the bootlid? No, we don't include hinges with bootlid. We normally sell bootlid hinges separately.

How would I know what sub-assembly parts are still with the bootlid/tailgate?

Search for the bootlid/tailgate in Pinnacle and put a tick beside it and you will see in the pop up box which are still in stock and which are not.

What if customer only noted they need the boot/tailgate? No comment about sub-assy or if shell only?

In this case, just quote the door and note "SHELL ONLY" in your quote

What if there is a comment in Pinnacle "LESS TRIM or LESS MIRROR" should we note that still when quoting the boot/tailgate shell?

No, do not mention any sub-assy missing since you are only quoting the shell.

What if we quoted SHELL ONLY and customer ordered but asking to send as COMPLETE? Check what still comes with the part (ie. window glass, lock, etc) and advise customer about it. Also advise customer that SUB-ASSY ARE NOT PART OF THE SALE - NO REPLACEMENT/REFUND IF ITS NO GOOD OR DIFFERENT If customer agree, then add the sub-assy parts in the work order separate by following this guide for CUSTOMER ORDERED MAIN PART AND SUB ASSEMBLIES
