Use a one-column format in A4 paper (210 x 297mm). The abstract should be consisting of summary for the paper. Total number of words in summary should be around 250 words. The abstract should be written in English and Indonesian.

INTRODUCTION (12pt, TNR)

Introduction explains the background and state of the art of research that has been done on the same topic and gap analysis to show where the contribution of the research conducted to the development of the discourse on the topic (novelty), this is an argument why the submitted article is an interesting and important research result to be done. The Introduction structure begins with the definition of the research topic. Then continued with a description of the research problem, research objectives, introduction to the literature review, related literature survey, literature review, objectives of recent works, contributions of the research conducted, expected main results (can be described in the form of research hypotheses), implications of the research results. Ends with an outline of the article structure. Each relationship or explanation of variables must be accompanied by a previous research basis from reputable articles, both national and international (at least 3 articles each in reputable journals). It is mandatory to paraphrase the theory or quotations taken from previous articles. The entire introduction must be presented clearly and concisely. The proportion of the introduction is 15-20% of the total length of the article.(11pt, TNR, Space 1, Justify)

METHODS (12pt, TNR)

Explain the method used, if the research results then the contents include: 1) types and sources of data that describe data and information collection techniques, and 2) data analysis methods (example: contains data collection techniques (samples) and data analysis used and contains the research framework in the form of a research flowchart). Presented clearly and concisely.(11pt, TNR, Space 1, Justify)

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (12pt, TNR)

Consisting of two main parts of the results and discussion without having to separate between the parts. The division of sub-sections in the Results and Discussion must describe and follow the sequence of research objectives. The results present empirical findings from the research conducted, while the discussion discusses the findings obtained. The discussion of findings not only presents the story behind the data but also compares the results obtained with previous research. Comparison with other research results also serves to show the position of the research conducted in the midst of the relevant topic discourse. At the end, the managerial implications of the results and discussion should be presented, especially for the business world. The entire Results and Discussion should be presented directly and concisely.(11pt, TNR, Space 1, Justify)

CONCLUSION (12pt, TNR)

Conclusions should be in the form of a response to the intended purpose and not intended as a summary of the results. Suggestions are in the form of follow-up (implications) that should be carried out in connection with the findings or conclusions of the author. Overall conclusions and recommendations should be presented directly and concisely written in essay form, not in numerical form.(11pt, TNR, Space 1, Justify)

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS (12pt, TNR)(Optional)

Acknowledgements are addressed to official institutions or individuals as funders or who have made other contributions to the research. Acknowledgements are accompanied by the research contract letter number.(11pt, TNR, Space 1, Justify)

BIBLIOGRAPHY (12pt, TNR)

Authors are advised to use Mendeley, Zotero, Endnotes or other Reference Management citation applications with the citation and reference style used as a guideline for writing citations and reference lists is the American Psychological Association Style (APA Style) 7. The number of quality references (primary, current, relevant) is at least 10. The reference list should be in the form of literature published in the last 10 years and 80% from national and international articles published by reputable journals.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Articles are typed using MS Word Document format (Compatibility Mode). The number of words from the introduction to the conclusion is 3000-6000 words. Each beginning of the paragraph is indented, except for the first paragraph at the beginning of each chapter. If there are sub-chapters, do not use numbering, just bold. Footers are not allowed.

Number and Table Formats

The number and title of the figure should be written below the figure, while the number and title of the table should be written above the table. It is recommended that tables and graphs are not in the form of images. Try to create tables and graphs in Microsoft Office Excel and Microsoft Office Word. Decimals are indicated by commas and not periods (eg 10.5 cm, not 10.5 cm); the number of thousands/millions is indicated by a period, not a comma (eg Rp10,500, not USD 10,500); However, for English articles, follow international standards. Large numbers can be replaced with title words (eg 2 million, not 2,000,000).

Mathematical Model Format

For the convenience of reading the journal, it is recommended to limit the number of mathematical models written in the article, for cases of extensive use of mathematical models, place them in the appendix. It is recommended to use Microsoft Equation Models for mathematical equations and symbols. The

recommended units of measurement are the metric system (eg, m, m², liters, and oC). The word percent is expressed by the character %, written without spaces from the previous number (eg 10%).

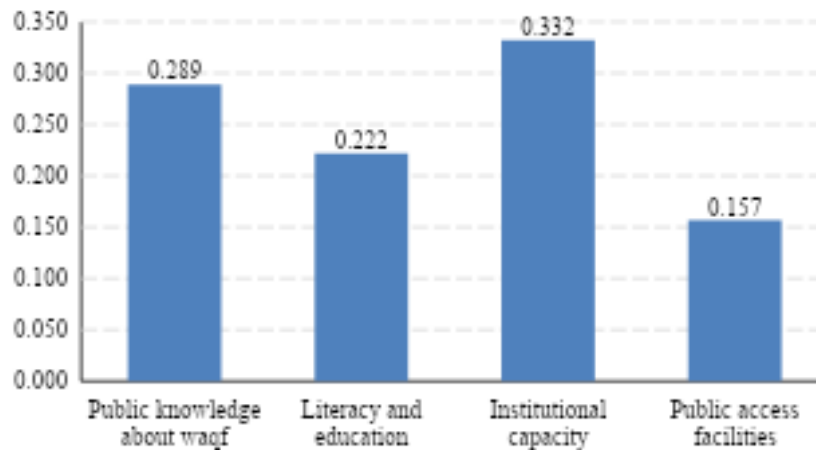


Figure 2. Distribution of Problem Priorities in Aspects of Collection
