

Mixed Media - Final Project - Choose your own adventure

This year you will be selecting and creating your own final assessment. You will create your assignment, the format in which you want to present it and the content you want to work with related to journalism.

Phase 1 - Selecting a topic and/or mode to do the project in. **Due 4/24**

Column A - Topics	Column B - Mode
journalism ethics photojournalism coverage of any major event journalism history technology	investigative feature photo essay series of short form pieces podcast video scrapbook/yearbook style

Phase 2 - Writing an assignment sheet - You will submit a formal assignment sheet for me to understand what your project is. You will have time in class to complete this. Your final draft will be due via google docs on **due 5/2**

- all assignments MUST have multiple elements
- all assignments MUST include at least 2 interviews to gather information
- all assignments MUST include secondary research of some kind
- all assignments MUST have a written AND visual element

Phase 3 - a Formal mode of assessment (rubric, checklist with standards, scale, etc) **due on 5/9**

- all assessments MUST be based on the [next generation learning standards](#)
- all assignments must explicitly tell what success indicators are

Phase 4 - Work on your project in class - students must schedule conference time along the way - **due 5/31**

- You will create a timeline appropriate for your work schedule in class and share it with me (actually written down)
- create benchmarks to help manage your time

Phase 5 - Reflection - standards-based reflection on your learning experience - beginning to end due **6/3**

- Reference learning to standards
- be in essay form - single spaced
- grade yourself and justify it

Phase 6 - Presentation - you will be presenting about your experience. due **June 3rd - Monday - More on this to follow as it gets closer**

Phase 7 - Eportfolio uploading due **June 3rd**
