The abstract is written in Indonesian and English. The abstract consists of 200 words written in one paragraph. Keywords are written after the abstract. Keywords must be not more than 5 (five) words or phrases. The selected keywords must reflect the concepts contained in the article. Keywords are needed to help increase the ease of access to the relevant article in the search engine.

INTRODUCTION

The introduction contains background information supported by facts, concepts, theories, and research results from relevant and recent reference sources. This section also discusses the novelty, differences between this study and previous studies, and the contribution of this study to the development of the field of science. At the end of the introduction, the research objectives are clearly stated.

Citations from related references are written using standard citation applications. References are written as follows.

1. Journals, books, proceedings: (Christofer et al., 2018; Pardede and Mardiaman, 2023; Widianto et al., 2022)*).
- *) More than 3 authors written by et al.
2. Regulations: (Government Regulation, 2019)

Articles must be written in English. The minimum number of pages for an article is 7. Manuscripts must be written according to the template on A4 paper (210mm x 297mm). The format is 30 mm left margin, 25 mm right margin, 25 mm bottom margin, and 30 mm top margin, with 12 pt *Times New Roman* font, single spacing. The article is written in two columns of equal width. The article is organized in the following order: Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, References. Foreign words or terms are italicized (*italic*).

METHOD

The methods section contains the types of methods used, the population and

sample, and the research sampling techniques, the types and techniques used in data collection, and the techniques used in data processing and analysis.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The results section presents answers to research questions in an accurate, complete, and clear manner. Illustrations in the form of tables or figures can be used to complement the results presentation to clarify and shorten the description. Authors should not repeat data that has already been presented in tables or figures. Research results must be discussed clearly and in detail. Discussions must be supported by primary and recent references.

Insert tables after they are cited in the text. Place the table heading above the table. There should be an introductory narrative before or after tables and figures. Use 12 pt Times New Roman for table headings, and center them (see Table 1).

Insert images after they are referenced in the text. Place image captions below the images and center them. Use 12 pt Times New Roman for image captions.

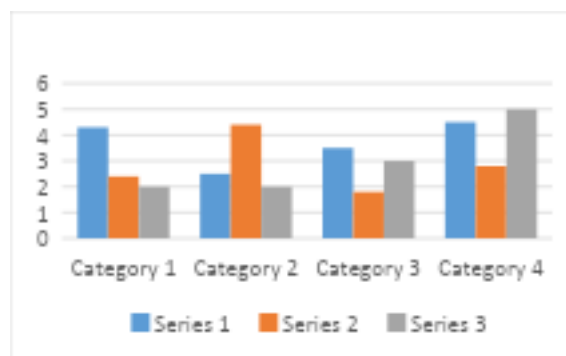


Figure 1. Image Display Style

Each image displayed needs to be clearly explained and interpreted. Do not repeat data that is already clearly displayed in the image. The same applies to tables.

CONCLUSION

Conclusions are a summary of the main findings of the research that answer the research objectives. Recommendations are formulated based on the research findings. Recommendations can be addressed to researchers, practitioners, or relevant policymakers. The writing is in paragraph form, not bullet points (1,2,3)

REFERENCES

The manuscript is supported by relevant reference sources. The reference sources used must be primary sources, namely articles published in national/international scientific journals within the last 10 years. The minimum number of primary sources is 10 journal articles, with 20% published within the last 3 years. Authors must not quote anonymously or use anonymous references. The references listed in the reference list are only those cited in the

text (not all references listed in the thesis/dissertation/report reference list). References in the reference list are sorted alphabetically (A-Z). In-text citations and reference sources in the reference list must follow the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA Style). The reference list must be created using a standard citation application, such as Mendeley.
