Divisions:

- Open Sport Horse – proposal to keep this division for following reasons
 - *Majority of kids signed up for flat classes, but two want to jump. If we have the division back to 10 with drop classes, the jumping kids have an advantage in points.*
 - *The jumping kids will go in all 10 classes, and there would be less kids than placings either way so unless they get DQ, everyone places in everything they go in.*
 - *The people with horses that can't or don't jump for any reason automatically have 3 classes they get no points. The jumping kids have a high probability of getting points in all classes because less people than placings. So, they're going to drop whatever their low stuff is, which means they'll have 3 firsts of 2nds from over fences, and dropping things they probably placed in.*
 - *While historically people have won the division without jumping, historically we had more people than placings so the chance of placing in every class was lower.*

 - Chrissy second
 - All in favor – motion approved

RULES:

- Speed & Control- question why we are allowed to circle the box multiple times. County & State rules were read; there is nothing in the state rulebook about circling the box before so rule was left as it is
- Changing Coggins to "current year active coggins". The issue is this a state rule from Jan 1 of current year to fair. Left rule as it is.
- Combine western & ranch again. Our rules already deal with the size of the divisions. Kids in the western division stated they liked having the separate divisions & kids in the ranch division stated they liked having the separate divisions. It was stated maybe wait on another year to see how numbers are going before we decide to make numbers higher to create divisions.
- Versatility- wants more people watching in the tack change/paddock. Not really needed in the rules, but more of re-emphasizing rules at the grooms meeting and having people watch/telling people to stop when grooming time is up
- Adding a cleaning deposit to fair. (copy/paste from email) The logistics of monitoring the stalls to give the deposits back at the end would be very difficult to manage. Perhaps having an added duty of picking up manure in front of the barns would be helpful.
- Stall decorations to be taken down Monday after fair through August 15. Not at all during fair.
- Points program left in the building. There were issues last year that caused it need to be in a quiet area. Points were done both by hand & computer. Decided to leave the double check as it is.
- Change number of ribbons to a set number or leave it where if X then 6, if Y then 8. Sara J motion to change rule to 8 ribbons no matter how many in the division. Chrissy M. second. All in favor.
- (rules 39 & 40) Change Coggins date to Jan 1.
- Add Grievance committee back in to rules. Rule 40. Change the rule to sending an email to Horse Committee with the required info. HC forwards email to all voting member of HC to discuss. Advisors and parents are excluded from this discussion. If a change for lameness, illness, or death will

keep high point & versatility eligibility. Seat changes and division changes must be stated in the grievance email. Changes for any other reason will not have high point or versatility.

- Raise the minimum hours to 10 for the first horse and 5 for each subsequent horse. Advanced notice of work dates and more work dates are recommended. Judi M motion to raise hours to 10 hours for first horse & 5 for subsequent horses. Lauren S. second. 5 in favor, 1 opposed, 1 abstain.
- Suggestion to limit number of contest horses per person. States you can't do this in other divisions. There is technically no rule that says you can do this in ranch. (Rule 32). Tabled until next meeting. We will look at the old SCSHA rules.
- Pallavi V. motion to change all 4 open pleasure divisions to have 7 of 9 classes count for high point Lauren S. second. All in favor. Will decide what classes at a later division.
- Add to regression rule that if enough regressions occur, then there may be a division. Will decide in July if we do anything with regressions based on numbers.
