This company-wide, professional development and networking program requires 10% of their work time and connects socially- and environmentally-minded SAP employees with their peers, creating opportunities for them to flex and grow their capacity for leadership, focus on their career journey, and help social enterprises scale their success and in turn, their positive impact on the world.
Where	Virtual, available for all global employees regardless of location.
When	SAP employees who join this flexible leadership program dedicate up to 10% of their work time based on interest and need for the project match. Participants must complete the program's mandatory onboarding and can then get started "experteering" (volunteering their expertise) with a social enterprise. Additional, optional learning and certifications are also available to employees. The work of partnership together to solve a concrete business challenge the social enterprise is experiencing will be completed within a timeframe deemed best for both the employee and social entrepreneur. - What is the time commitment for employees?
   Flexible and adaptable to their schedules, as well as the variations in them. Employees can expect to invest a few hours a week while active in the program, on trainings, team meetings, and project work with their social enterprise. Employees will work with the social enterprise to align on a schedule, and communicate that to you, their manager.
- 2. Will the program adapt to end-of-quarter and busy periods of work?
  YES! This program is flexible to allow employees to invest in it while still meeting their SAP goals.
  Certain program components are optional, and the length encourages employees to take breaks to accommodate busy periods.
- 3. What is the time commitment expected of me (manager) during this program?
