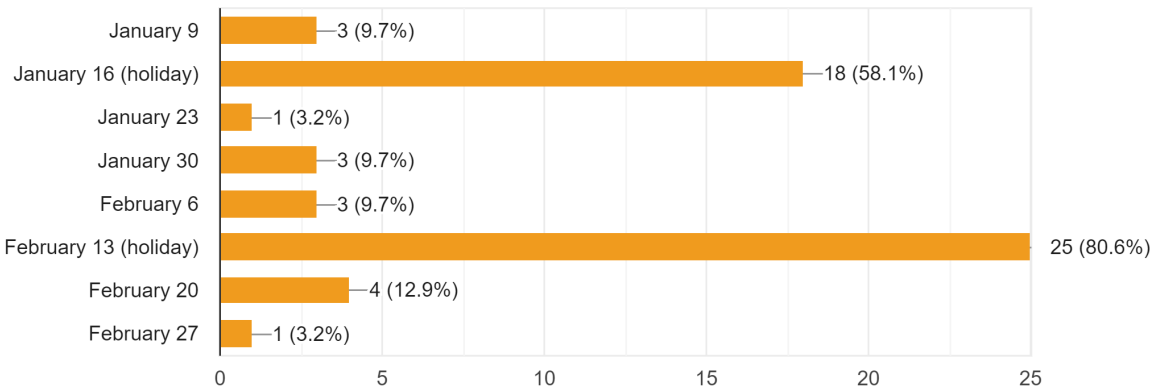

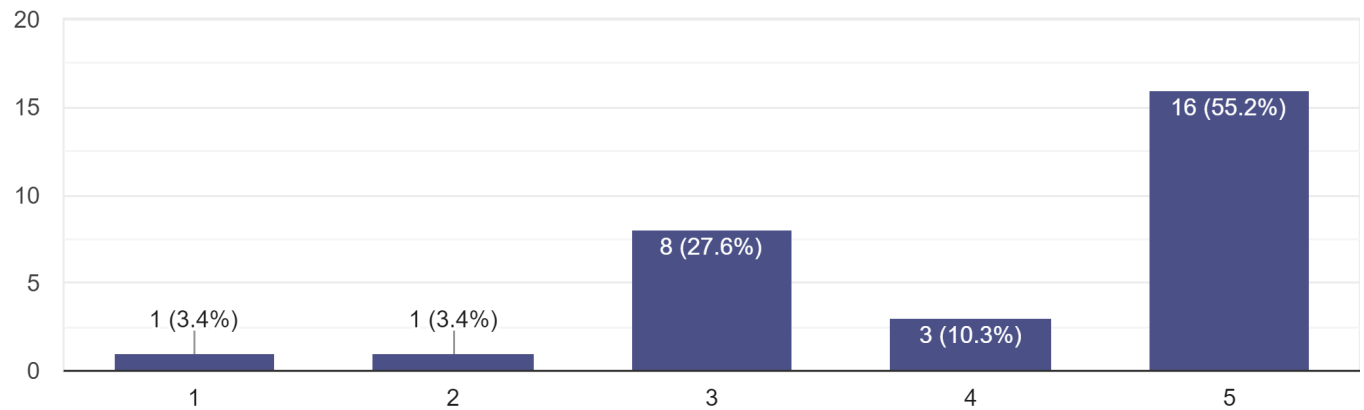

Season Planning Survey (29 responses as of 11/8/20)

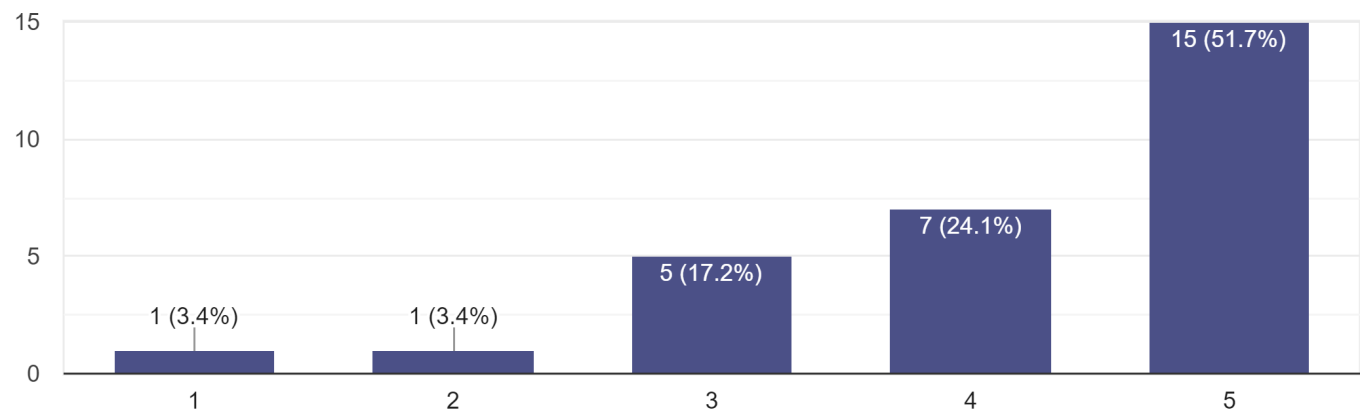
Knowing that teams will most likely be required to stay in their own region, it's important that events in each region are similar.

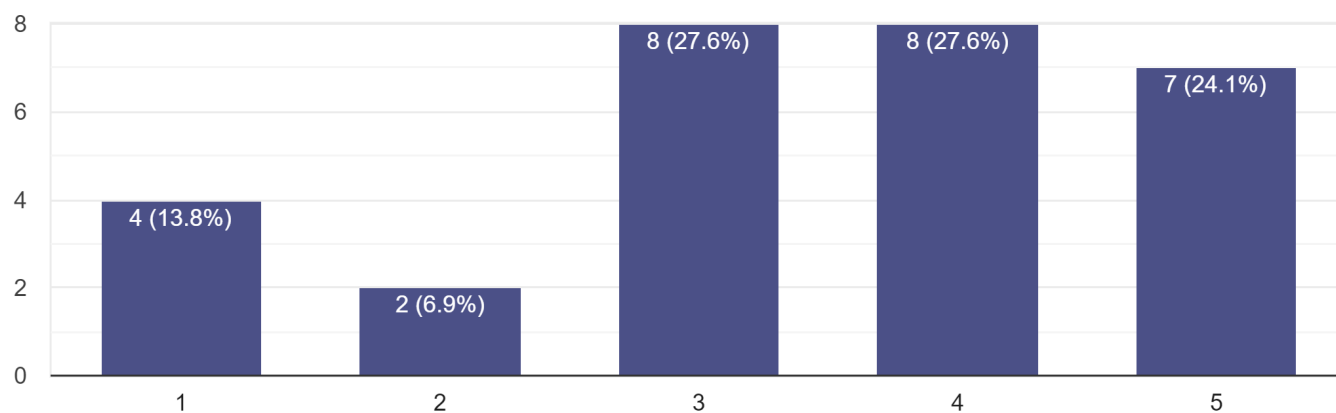

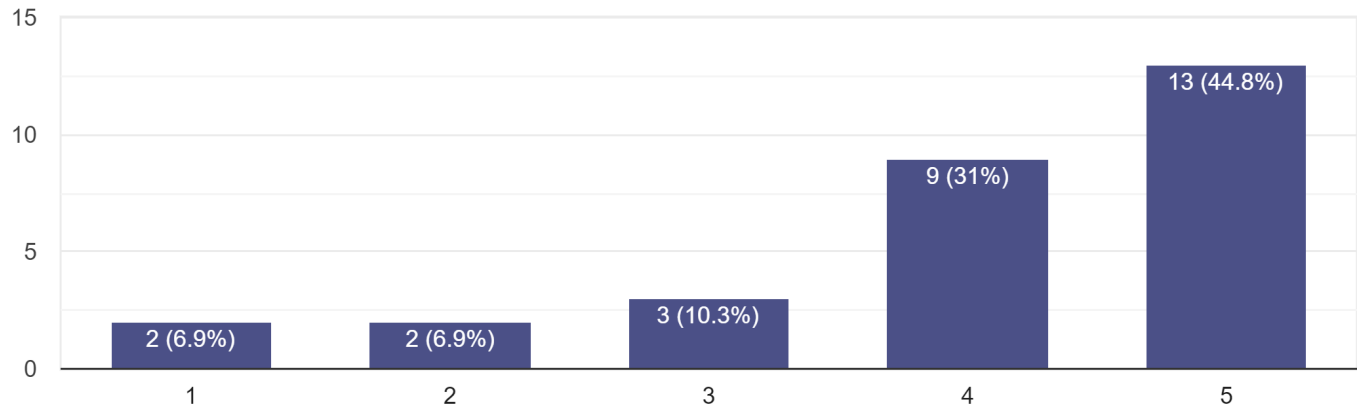
If events do not follow the normal competition format this year, my team might try something new, like perform in a category not currently offered in W...w all dancers to perform, regardless of skill level.

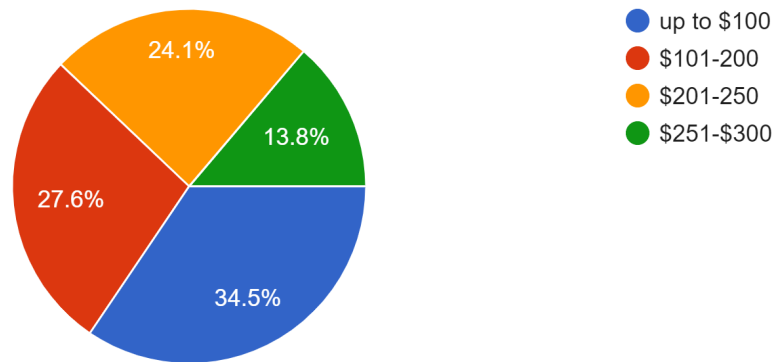
If in-person events are not possible, a virtual event would be a good alternative (could be competitive or non-competitive)

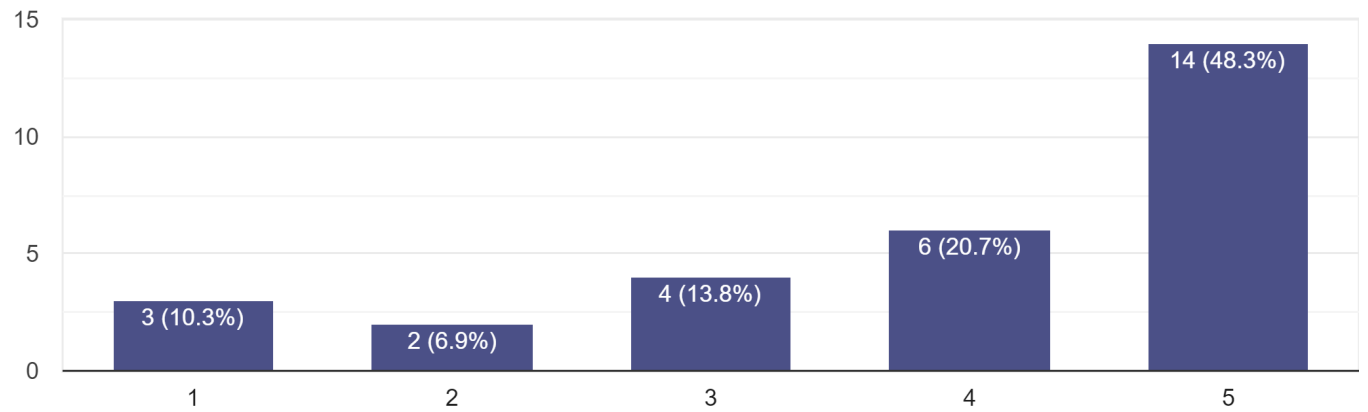
What would be the maximum you would be willing to pay for your team for one event to cover expenses (1-3 routines)? \$250 is the current WIAA limit.

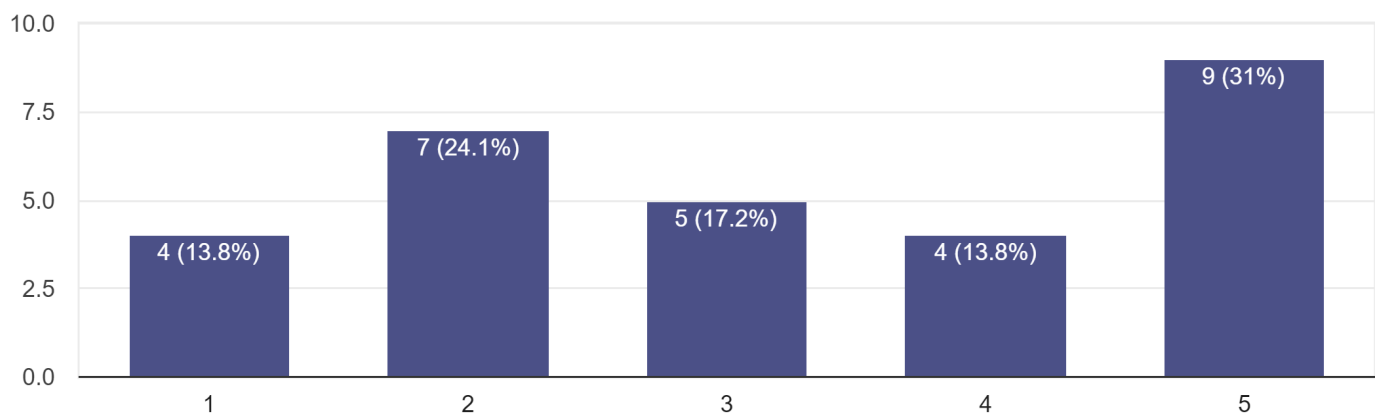
If competitions happen, it's important that teams are guaranteed a minimum number of competitions.

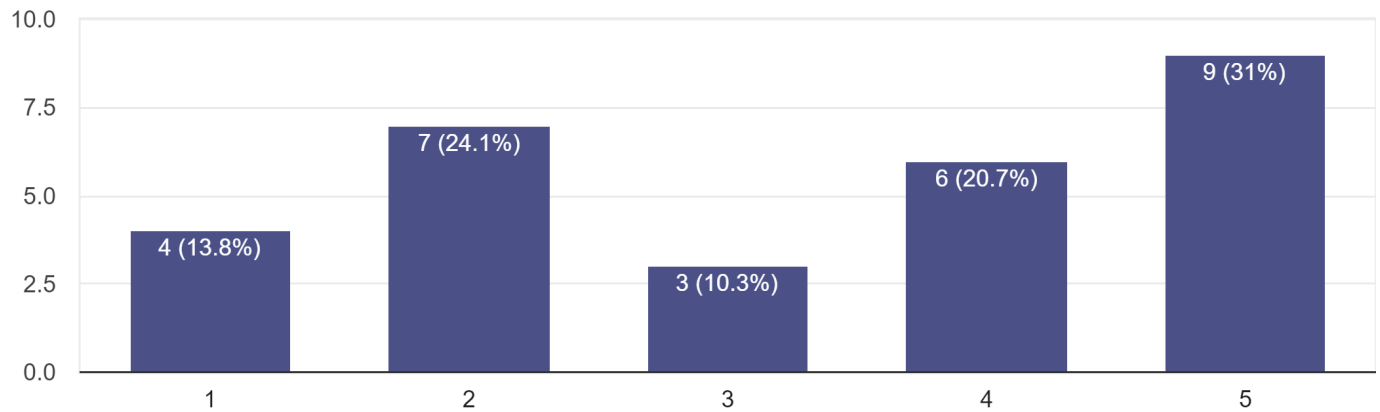
Middle level teams should have the opportunity to participate in events that occur.
