Conversion Therapy Amendment (Pychiatric Consultation) Bill 2022

OUTLINE

This bill strengthens the institutional defences against coercive and non-consentual use of conversion therapy by forcing the statuatory declaration necessary to be signed to become a participant in conversion therapy to be witnessed by an acreddited psychiatrist who has had a consultation with the potential participant outlining the full risks involved. In addition it strengthens the legal penalties for violation of the Conversion Therapy Act, doubling prison sentances from 10 years to 20 while adding a 10 year prison sentence for pychiatrists who witness a statuarytory declaration for conversion therapy found to contain false information.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

This bill will not result in additional Commonwealth spending.

STATEMENT OF COMPATIBILITY WITH HUMAN RIGHTS

Conversion Therapy Amendment (Pychiatric Consultation) Act 2022 This bill is compatible with the human rights and freedoms recognised or declared in the international instruments listed in section 3 of the Human Rights (Parliamentary Scrutiny) Act 2011.

HUMAN RIGHTS IMPLICATIONS

This Bill engaged with the freedoms and rights enshrined in the Convention Against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment done at New York on 10 December 1984, notably Articles 16, which prohibits "cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment which does not amount to torture" under the juristiction of participating member states.

Conclusion

This bill is compatible with human rights and enhances the human rights of Australians by enhancing protections against the coercive and unconsentual participation in conversion therapy practices.
