Leader in Training Job Description

Summary: Leaders in Training report directly to the Camp Director and the Executive Directors. LIT's are responsible for aiding in the supervision of all camp participants. LIT's will be responsible for assisting the counselors in the daily administration of the summer camp program, including ensuring the well-being and safety of all participants, administering games and activities, maintaining a fun and safe environment for all participants, and helping keep the camp cabin clean.

Requirements: Must be 16 years of age or older, available to volunteer from Sunday Noon- Friday Noon, willing to contribute to a hassle and bully-free environment, independent (setting their own daily alarms, being on time), willing to take direction from seasoned camp counselors, and have an open mind in order to not only accept but also embrace and celebrate our camper's differences.

Qualifications: Outgoing and energetic personality. Taking the initiative in socializing with campers is a must. Being friendly to all campers, staff, and volunteers.

Job Responsibilities: Ensure that campers are supervised at all times and maintain a safe and enjoyable camp environment. Follow instructions of the counselors and aid in all daily activities. Conduct headcounts of participants throughout the day. Ensure participants are safe (properly hydrated, playing areas are free of hazards, etc.) **Follow all protocols found in the handbook.** Interact with parents/guardians during drop-off on Sundays and pick-up on Fridays. Maintain the integrity of the camp cabins and help with set-up and clean-up of the camp area. **Complete all applications and turn in all required documents on time.**

MedCamps leadership holds the right to dismiss any LIT that is deemed as not contributing to our goal of maintaining a safe, fun, and hassle-free environment for all staff, campers, and other LIT's. By applying for our LIT program, all parents of minors accept the responsibility and agreement that, if the occasion occurs, they may have to come and retrieve their child from MedCamps' physical campsite. Parents of any minor who is dismissed early will be notified via the information provided on our application.
