Goals for 2021/2022

- Continue to collaborate and create new opportunities with Day By Day Warming Shelter and St. Anne's Medical Clinic.
 - Weekly prayer/bible group at DBD
 - Individual Healing Prayer as requested – DBD & St. Anne's
 - Annual Memorial Service scheduled for 3/15/22 at DBD
 - Homeless guests are attending our Masses at SP
- Continue to support families in need and refugee families referred to MBS by Oshkosh Kids Foundation or the Diocese.
 - Working with the Diocese to learn more about how our parish can support refugee families and what the guidelines are. (Last year we had a refugee family we supported with physical and monetary needs, but we did not know the extent to which our help was required, i.e. tax paperwork, social security numbers, bank account setup, etc.)
- Continue to work with Jane Angha and Ministry Blueprints on Radical Hospitality
 - Collaborate with new Relationship Coordinator to continue the development of the Connection Centers and Mission Center Connection Center.
 - Develop and implement funeral hospitality – at Masses and Luncheons
 - Hospitality gifts given to new members, baptismal families, wedding couples
 - Collaborate with other parish departments on creating an environment of radical hospitality (Appreciation Dinner, Memorial Mass for Deceased, St. Nicholas event, Lenten Bible Study, Corpus Christi event, etc.)
- Grief Support
 - Ongoing Hope and Healing program in collaboration with St. Raphael.
 - Care Notes mailing program for families who have had a funeral at MBS.
- Annual Senior Census Update and Care Ministry program
 - Annual form was mailed out on February 4th
 - Care Ministry to respond based on needs indicated.
 - Care Ministry meeting scheduled for March 1st – Recruit, Retrain, Meet the needs
- Healing Prayer Ministry
 - Currently have 8 students in the Encounter School of Ministry – Year 1
 - Scholarships to be provided for Year 2
 - Prayer offered at weekend Masses and/or upon request
 - Collaborating with Liturgy on monthly "Encounter" Holy Hour with Healing Prayer Teams and Healing Mass with Anointing of the Sick.
 - Provide Healing Prayer Teams at Newman Center "Well" and other events
