4. PUBLIC COMMENT ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS:

Andi Justice introduced herself as the new Office Assistant and shared that she is the parent of three West Side students in grades 1, 3, and 6. Karen Stepp, parent of a 1st and 2nd grade student, distributed a copy of an email she sent to the Board on October 14, 2025, regarding the revised morning drop-off procedures (see attached). Ms. Stepp provided a summary of the email during the meeting. Several parents and a grandparent of two students who were present expressed concerns regarding safety when the campus is open to parents during morning drop-off. A few parents participating via Zoom expressed support for allowing parents to access the playground during this time. Three teachers participating via Zoom stated that the faculty supports the newly revised "Morning Drop-off Procedures" and emphasized the safety of all students, as well as the support for independence in their developmental growth. A classified staff member also spoke, noting safety considerations and the challenges of supervising students when multiple adults are present on the playground. A parent requested the creation of a designated community gathering area on campus. Superintendent Meechan suggested forming a stakeholder committee to explore this idea.
