Call meeting to Order: Kristen Duguid

- Welcome: Meeting called to order at 8:27am

Principal Update: Dr. Gates

- Boosterthon
 - Students are very excited; Dr. Gates reported hearing lots of chatter around school
 - Parents are reminded to RSVP with the school for the event if they plan on attending
- Testing
 - Testing continues to be a challenge due to the school's large size
 - There are not enough computers to accommodate all students efficiently
 - Hoping we can raise enough money through booster-thon to purchase 2 computer carts
- School Growth
 - Enrollment has surpassed 1,100 students, which has provided the school with an additional resource teacher
 - A drama program is being added at the elementary level. This teacher has been hired and is being processed through the district now. They will have a classroom in the portables
 - The addition of new electives has had a positive impact on student behavior at the school level, as students are more engaged in classes they enjoy
- Character Counts
 - September's meeting has been rescheduled to October 2nd
- Millage Increase
 - The community voted to approve the increase, which has been very beneficial
 - The school is now fully staffed
 - The district has hired over 30 new bus drivers, made possible by increased wages funded through the millage
- SAC (School Advisory Council)
 - Membership includes 50% teachers and 50% community members
 - SAC receives district funding, which can be used to support student data improvement initiatives
 - Meetings are held monthly on the 3rd Tuesday at 3:30 p.m.
 - SAC committee is urging parents to attend

 - PTO will add \$500 to the annual budget for this program
