 - a. Transferable skills of SWIRL (Speaking, Writing, Inquiry, Reading, Listening)

 - a. Goal 4: Behavior Responses
 - i. Creating a lunchtime lounge for students to reflect on their behaviors. **\$3,000**
 - ii. Supplies to build the program **\$2,793**
 - iii. Two primary goals:
 1. Ensure healthy school environment with safety priority
 2. Decrease suspensions through alternative behavioral corrections
 - iv. Key data: Steady suspension decrease over past 4 years, targeting additional 1% reduction over next 3 years
 - v. Current strategies working:
 1. School-wide SEL lessons by student advisors
 2. Student improvement luncheons (attendance/behavior/grades recognition)
 3. Mental health groups and tobacco/drug prevention programs
 4. Restorative practices with family involvement
 5. Weekly care team meetings for at-risk students
 - vi. New additions:
 1. Single point of entry implementation
 2. Additional fencing installation over summer

3. Proposed “lunchtime lounge” for behavioral reflection (\$2,793 allocation)
 - vii. Plan approved unanimously for board submission
- b. Goal 3: Achievement of English Learners - Pull-out day for EL teachers once a month, and College Field Trip **\$3,000**
 - i. 89% of teachers completed Elevation Module 2 (Academic Language Development)
 - ii. LPAC professional development sessions provided
 - iii. ELD cohort pull-outs focusing on SDAIE strategies
- c. Goal 1: College and Career & Goal 2: Graduation Rate
 - i. Pull-out days for cohorts once a month (5 teachers) **\$5,000**
 - ii. Pull-out days and College Field Trips for AVID (4 teachers) **\$4,000**
 - iii. Current enrollment: 2,000 students (down from 2,400 five years ago)
 - iv. Projected 2026-27 enrollment: 1,959 students
 1. Incoming freshman class: 467 students
 2. Represents loss of approximately 3 sections per subject

New recruitment initiatives:

- First shadow day event hosted 25 Leyva students
- Middle school visits to Quimby and Shibuya completed
- Parent information night scheduled for tonight
- Students asking about business pathway, band, math programs, school safety

Launch 9 program proposed for freshman transition support:

- Focus on biology, geometry, English 1 teachers using consistent routines
- Executive functioning skills (planners, Canvas navigation, organization)
- Teacher collaboration through monthly pull-out days
- All ninth grade teachers included to ensure comprehensive coverage

- 2026-27 preliminary budget: \$273,237 (10% decrease from current year)
- Title I funding bump: \$17,793 additional due to increased free/reduced lunch qualifications
- Total available: ~\$325,000 including Title II professional development funds
- Proposed \$17,793 allocation approved:
- Lunchtime lounge: \$2,793
- Monthly teacher cohort pull-outs: \$5,000
- AVID college field trips: \$4,000
- EL teacher pull-outs and college trips: \$3,000
