A number of great films and directors created my appreciation for the film and television industry, which eventually led me to my interest and involvement towards media. I always had an interest in film but Ridley Scott's gladiator stands out in my mind more than anything else. It immediately grabbed my attention. To create the score Hans Zimmer watched the film in silent and imagined what it would sound like if he were in the cinema, which is a technique rumoured to be used by a lot of composers. After his dedicated work with co composer Lisa Gerrard they both received the award for best original music score at the Golden globes, although there was some controversy at the awards ceremony beforehand.

Russell Crowe plays Maximus Decimus Meridius, destroyed by power he becomes a slave and fights his way back to authority to revenge his family. On its own it is a great story but with the intense performance by Russell Crowe and Joaquin Phoenix amongst others, it became an incredible film. When I saw this film for the first time I was about ten years old and I hadn't seen much outside of the cartoon world. Gladiator was the first film that gained my full concentration. This meant I appreciated the performance in a movie for the first time, and it set a marker for great films. Russell Crowe has also given great performances in L.a confidential and Ron Howard's A beautiful mind, two of my favourite films. It's clear to me that this actor was one of the main reasons I have such a passion for films and the media industry today.
