- How do astronauts sleep?
 - Astronauts float in the air when they sleep because there is no gravity to pull them down onto a bed.
- How do they brush their teeth?
 - When astronauts brush their teeth the tooth paste sticks to their toothbrush even when it is 'upside down. Water will also stick to their toothbrush but it will form into a bubble and float off if you don't put it on your brush.
- How does the 'bathroom' work?
 - Sunni says that you have to be careful to 'aim' correctly otherwise it will make a mess. The toilets have suction to keep the waste from escaping and floating around the space station.
- Why do you think that all of the surfaces have equipment stuck to them?
 - Astronauts do not 'walk' on the floor so all of the surfaces can hold equipment. The equipment must be stuck to the surfaces so that it does not float away.
- Why do you think her hair is standing up, even when she brushes her hair?
 - There is no gravity to make it lay down on your head.
