



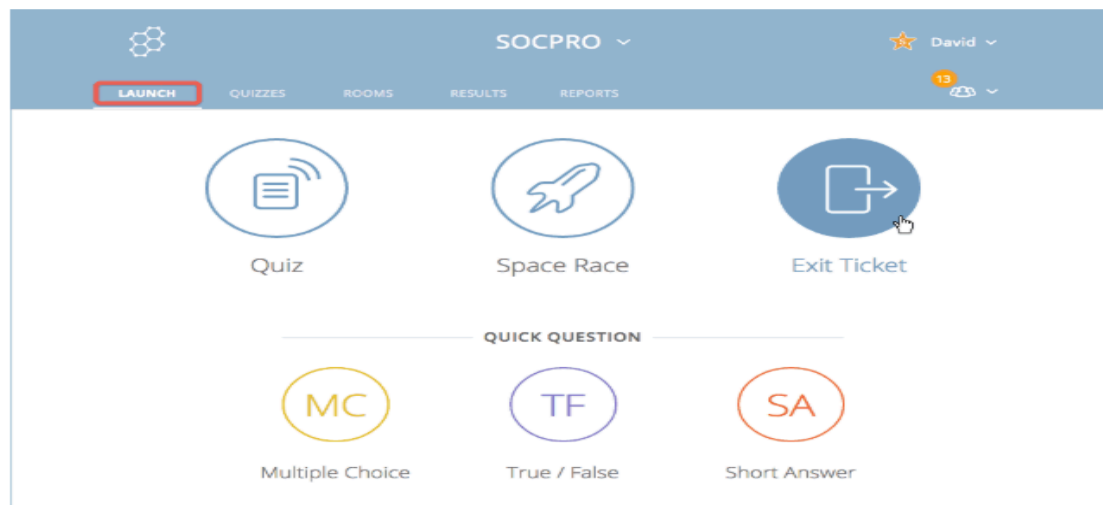

Socrative is a very useful tool for quick assessments!

The “Exit Ticket” option is very useful. The screenshots below will show you how that part works!

How To Deliver an Exit Ticket

Click on **Launch**, then click **Exit Ticket**.



Socrative's default Exit Ticket presents students with the following three questions:

1. How well did you understand today's material?
2. What did you learn in today's class?
3. Please answer the teacher's question.

Once all your students are done responding, click **Finish**.




As you finish, you will be asked if you would like to **Get Reports** for the exit ticket, click **View Chart** to see student results in a **Live Results** format, or return **To Launch**.

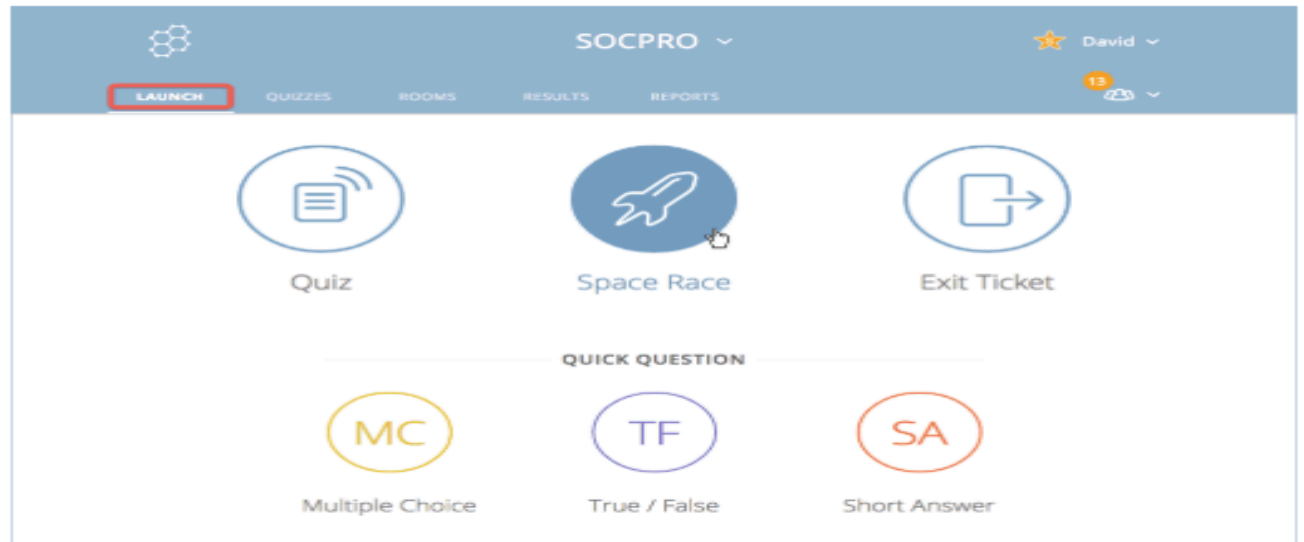

Step-by-Step

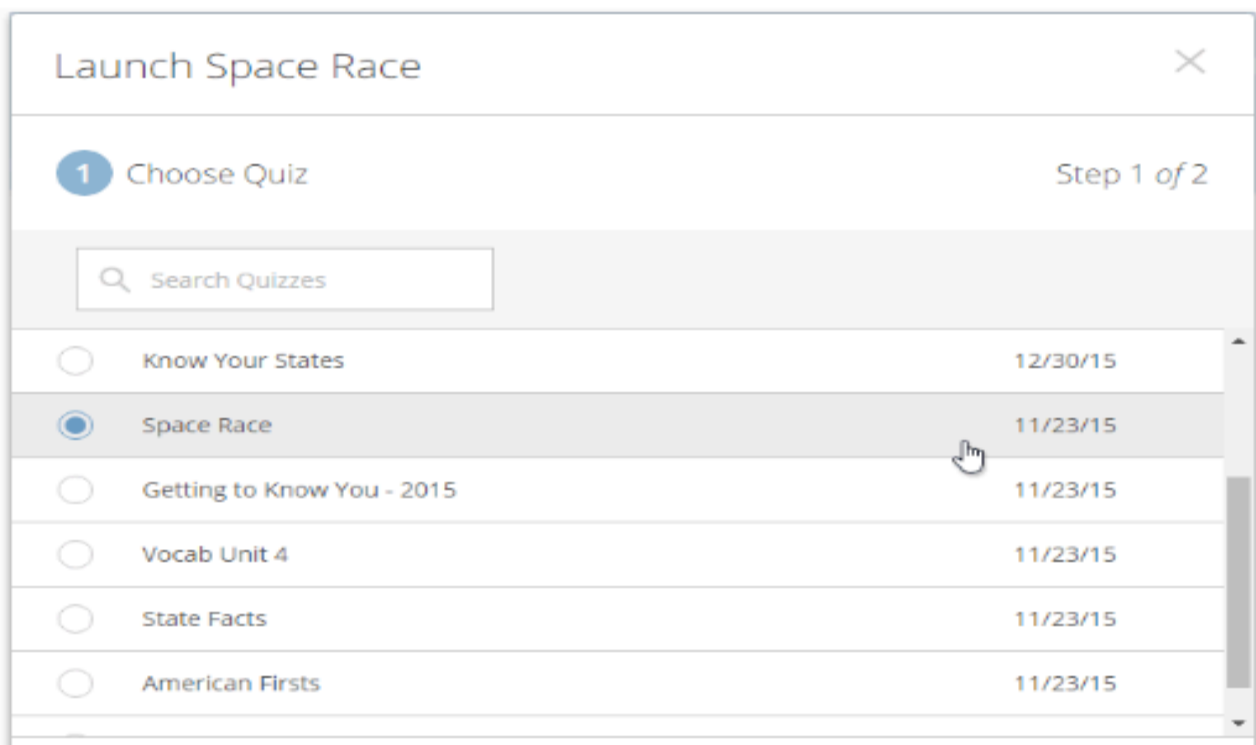
How to Run a Space Race

Click on **Launch**, then click on **Space Race**.



Select the quiz you want to deliver as a **Space Race**.

Note: Be sure the quiz you select has graded questions or else the rockets won't move.



Choose the number of teams. Students can:

- Play by themselves on their own computer or mobile device.
- Play together by sharing a single computer or mobile device.
- Play together on the same team, but answering on separate computers or mobile devices.

Note: If you choose auto-assign and there are more students than the number of teams, Socrative will attempt to split them evenly between teams.

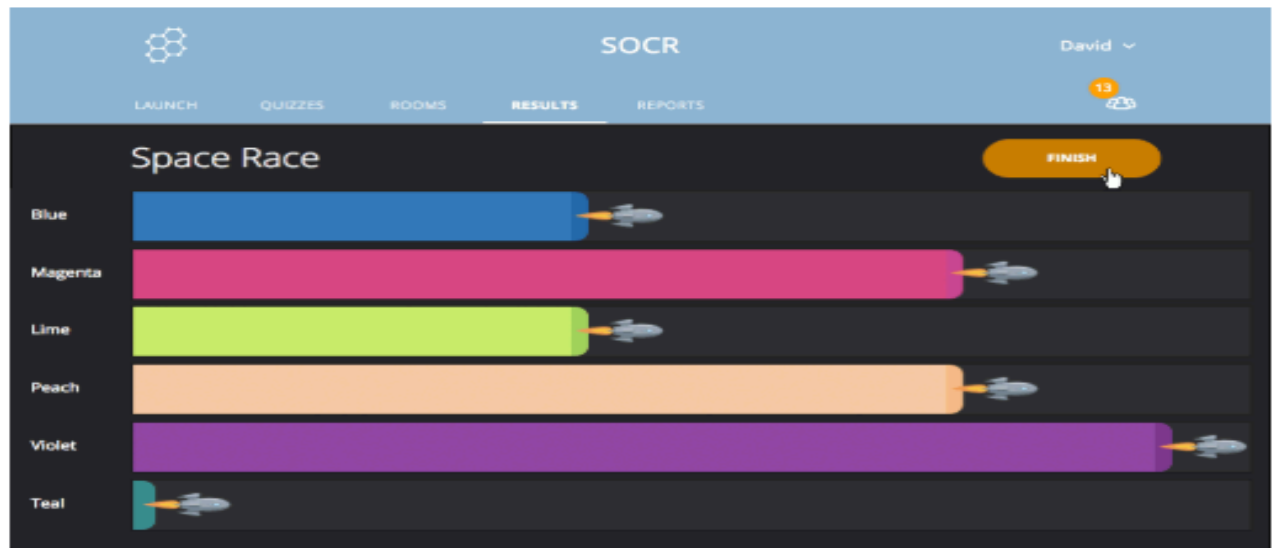
If you want to turn off the **Immediate Feedback** dialog to speed up the game, switch the following toggles from **YES** to **NO**.

Click on **Start** to begin the race!

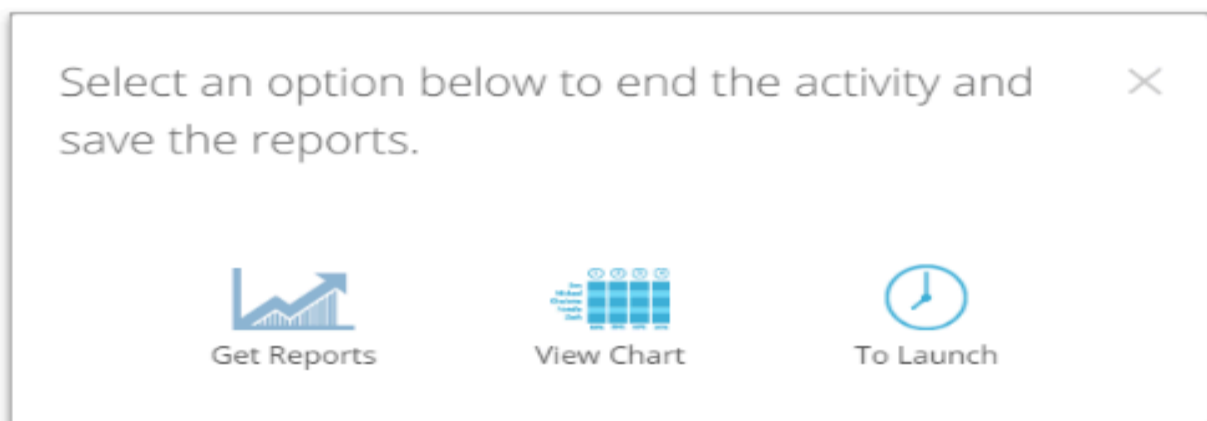
Note: Make sure your screen is projected so students can watch their progress.
