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"He is my son at heart. "We are brothers in the document, but he is my son and my best friend, I do everything to take care of him", this is how Moisés Costa, 52, defined the relationship with the young Davyd Cesario Silva, 25 years old.

The boy is diagnosed with cerebral palsy, epilepsy and lingering atrophy, in addition to cognitive impairment and was abandoned by his biological mother in the early months of life, in the capital Goiana.

Davyd was left by his mother at the house of Moses' family, who at the time was her ex-boyfriend, right after the birth. The case was disclosed by the Metropolis.

The woman claimed that the man would be the father of the child, however, the assumption was ruled out by a DNA test. The young man doesn't walk, doesn't talk and has the understanding of a baby.

Moisés told that he learned about the pregnancy of Davyd's mother when she was already five months old. According to him, an instinct said he wasn't the child's father.

"We 'stayed', but she lived in an inner city. She called me and said she was pregnant at five months and then disappeared. When Davyd was about a couple months old, she went home and said she needed to get some groceries and she would leave him there. My mother insisted she not leave him, but she didn't come back," he said.

The young man's foster father says that shortly after the boy got sick and needed to be taken to hospital. "Because he had many seizures and faints, he needed medical attention, but for that, civil registration was needed. My mom and stepdad registered Davyd to save his life," reports.
