We are making every effort to ensure a safe and smooth conclusion to the school year for your child. The following policies will be in effect on exam days (6/15, 6/16, 6/17, 6/21, & 6/23):

- Students will not be allowed to bring backpacks or book bags to school.
- Cell phones and electronic devices are prohibited in testing locations. They will be collected and stored during the exam.
- No food or drink will be allowed in testing locations. .
- Morning exams will end at 11:00am and students will be dismissed to go home

For your convenience, transportation during Regents week will be as follows:

- There will be regular morning buses for students coming in to take each Regents exam
- There will be a 10:32 bus run for middle school students and any student who has completed their Regents exam
- Students with a morning exam need to exit the building and be picked up once their exam is completed
- Students who have a morning and afternoon exam should remain inside the building. These students will report to the cafeteria and remain there until 11:45am.

Please note that finals may be administered during this exam period. This information will be given to students by their classroom teachers. I hope this letter provides you with all of the information you and your child need for our upcoming June assessments. We are very proud of our students for their continued hard work throughout another challenging year.
