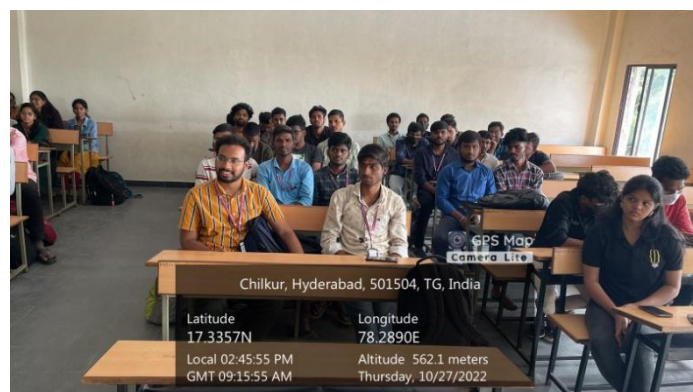
Objective: Opportunity for college students to be a part of India's leading digital inclusion movement.

Summary: At CodingForAll, they're working every day to provide digital literacy and coding skills to those 425 million children in India who do not have access to a computer. CodingForAll is a non-profit leading the digital inclusion movement in India by teaching coding in regional Indian languages to students who do not have access to a computer. CodingForAll runs its flagship program in government & affordable private schools to teach coding to secondary students and also equip them with other ancillary skills required for career readiness. Each of our students is part of our 'class to career pipeline' and our intervention with our students is for 8 years starting in secondary school, continuing through college, and supporting them till they land their first dream job. We also run other scale programs for students who are not part of CodingForAll to impact as many students as possible.
