Learning Outcomes

By the end of the lesson, students will be able to:

1. Use functional language to buy something in a shop

Target Language

Functional language for buying things in shops

Lesson Stages

1. Present the Target Language (5 minutes)
 - **Objective:** To distinguish between functional language for interacting in a shop
 - **Activity:** Show slide 2. Ask students to work together to decide if the language is for asking about an item, making a purchase, expressing interest, or being generally polite.
 - **Feedback:** Go through each phrase from top to bottom, asking students to call out their answers. Click to reveal answers and move them to the correct square of the table.
2. Stage 2: Jumbled Dialogue (5 minutes)
 - **Objective:** Recognise the logical order of a conversation.
 - **Activity:** Show slide 3. Ask students to work together to put the jumbled dialogues in the correct order (part 1 and part 2). Click to reveal the answers on screen.
 - Show slide 4. Get students to roleplay the conversations in pairs.
3. Stage 3: Roleplay - Buying something in a shop (10 minutes)
 - **Objective:** Use the new language in context
 - **Activity:** Separate students into pairs.
 - ◆ Show slide 5. Get students to roleplay the 3 situations, taking turns to be the shop assistant and the customer.

→ **Feedback:** Ask students if they managed to buy and sell their items. Ask how much money they spent.
