<u>TEXT</u>: Algebra and Trigonometry with Analytic Geometry

COURSE:

This course extends the concepts learned in Algebra 1. Students will investigate linear, quadratic, absolute value, polynomial, radical, logarithmic and trigonometric functions. Students will use these functions to model real life situations. Students will learn to approach problems numerically, graphically, algebraically and verbally.

The nature of this course is to have students engage in critical thinking, analysis, and explanation of their work. Understanding and explaining will be much more significant than providing an answer alone. Technology will be utilized in many modes to explore and discover new concepts.

COURSE POLICIES:

- **Class preparation**: Includes having a pencil, your homework completed on time, your notebook with blank paper inside, and a graphing calculator.
- **Notebook**: It is suggested to keep a three-ring binder as your notebook.
