DEAR LEXINGTON PARENTS AND STUDENTS,

The beginning of the school year is fast approaching, and our Whitsons School Nutrition team is ready and excited to provide nutritious, well-balanced meals to the Lexington School Community.

The federally assisted National School Lunch Program (NSLP) & School Breakfast Program (SBP) provide nutritionally balanced meals to children each school day. This year, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts has decided to extend **FREE school meals** for all students through the 2025-2026 school year. This means that one breakfast and one lunch will be served at no cost to all students in Lexington. **No form is needed to receive free meals.**

This letter contains important information, changes, and resources regarding our school meal programs as we move into the 2025-2026 school year. Please remember that changes to our programs may occur as circumstances evolve, but we will continue to update families on what to expect and how to navigate any changes.

FREE AND REDUCED APPLICATIONS

Although meals are free this year, we encourage low-income families to fill out an application to receive additional food assistance benefits when provided by the state of Massachusetts, associated with free and reduced eligibility status, such as the "Summer Eats Program". If your student is returning, please be aware that last year's status expires on **October 9th**, and your student's status will be returned to paid and will not be eligible to receive additional food assistance benefits that may become available through the State of Massachusetts if the district has not received a new application by that date. ONE FREE BREAKFAST & ONE FREE LUNCH PER STUDENT PER DAY

All reimbursable lunches include balanced portions of grains, proteins, vegetables, and fruits, and an optional 8-oz low-fat 1% or fat-free chocolate milk. **Students must take either a fruit or a vegetable with their meal for it to be considered free.** Additionally, a la carte fruit and milk cartons are available for purchase.

STUDENT LUNCH ACCOUNT PAYMENTS AND MONITORING

Student Lunch Account payments can be made through [MySchoolBucks.com](https://www.myschoolbucks.com) using a debit/credit card, or an electronic check. The fee for using MSB has increased for SY26 to \$3.50 for \$150.00 a maximum per transaction, debit/ credit; the e-check fee will remain the same. Other options are that payments can be submitted by sending cash or a check made out to "Town of Lexington" to:

Students can also drop cash/checks off at their school's cafeteria or main office. If you are mailing/dropping off a check, please include the student's full name and grade inside a sealed envelope.

Follow these steps to set up a [MySchoolBucks](https://www.myschoolbucks.com) account:

1. Download the app or visit the [MySchoolBucks](https://www.myschoolbucks.com) homepage and click on "Sign Up Free".
2. Create a user profile with your email address, establish a password, and set up your security questions.
3. Add a Student to your account using the student's name, date of birth, and/or student ID number (an 8-digit student ID number can be obtained by contacting the food service office or main office; Students in the LABBB Program will have a *10-digit number*).

Once you have added your student(s) to your account, you can make one-time payments or set up auto-pay. If you go into your profile, you may also set up low-balance notifications. When your child's balance goes below your specified amount, an email message will automatically be sent to the email address in your profile.

Students at the High School, Middle School, and Elementary school will be provided with a PIN code number to account for free meals and purchase a la carte items such as Smart Snack items, water, 2nd lunch, snacks, juices, ice cream, cookies, etc. We highly encourage all students to memorize their PINs for faster service. **Although reimbursable meals are free, please note that all meals must be accounted for through the cashier lines using PINs, and any a la carte items will be charged to the student's account.**

We strongly encourage you to utilize the payment options described above. This will help increase the speed of service.

HOW TO GET IN-SCHOOL MEALS

LEXINGTON CHILDREN'S PLACE IN-SCHOOL MEAL SERVICE

LCP parents must order all meals (breakfast and lunch) through the new MEALORDERS program.

Breakfast and lunch orders will be delivered to the classrooms. Please place all meal orders through [the new MEALORDERS program](#) before the cutoff time. [Log on instructions Here.](#)

- **Breakfast and lunch will be available every school day**
- **Preorder:** Meal Order Program
- **Preorder Cutoff Time:** 11 AM The Night Before
- **Meal Payment:** Reimbursable meals are FREE for ALL Lexington Public School students (one breakfast and lunch per student). Student accounts will be charged for any a la carte items or additional meals. Please ensure your student(s) have a positive account balance before ordering à la carte items or extra meals.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN-SCHOOL MEAL SERVICE

Students at the elementary school must pre-order lunch in the classroom during **homeroom attendance at the beginning of the day**. Breakfast will not be pre-ordered but will be made available half an hour before the school day begins.

Students will pick up their breakfast and lunch orders in the cafeteria. Students must enter their PIN code at the registers to account for free breakfasts/lunches and purchase à la carte items such as water, snacks, 2nd lunch, etc.

- **Breakfast and lunch will be available every school day**
- **Preorder:** Homeroom in the morning, Lunch Only.
- **Meal Payment:** Reimbursable meals are FREE for ALL Lexington Public School students (one breakfast and lunch per student). Student accounts will be charged for any a la carte items or additional meals. Please ensure your student(s) have a positive account balance before ordering a la carte items or extra meals.
- **Additional information:** On half-day Fridays, meals will still be served in the cafeteria, and seating will be provided. Breakfast and lunch will be provided on all half days in SY 2025-2026.

MIDDLE SCHOOL IN-SCHOOL MEAL SERVICE

Breakfast and lunch are served in the cafeteria. At each of the middle schools, students will have hot lunches and egg lunches available to them. **à la carte items** such as pre-made sandwiches, salad, hot lunch, Pizza, Coyote Grill, or Deli (Salads only available at Diamond MS). Students must enter their PIN code at the registers to account for free breakfasts/lunches, and purchases of à la carte items such as water, snacks, and 2nd lunch will be charged to the account. Students must have funds in their accounts to get extra items. No extra items will be made.

- **Breakfast and lunch will be available every school day**
- **Pre-order: Not Available.**
- **Meal Payment:** Reimbursable meals are FREE for ALL Lexington Public School students (one breakfast and lunch per student). Student accounts will be charged for any a la carte items or additional meals by using their PIN code. Please ensure your student(s) have a positive account balance before purchasing a la carte items or extra meals.
- **Additional information:** Breakfast and lunch will be provided on all half days in SY 2025-2026.

HIGH SCHOOL IN-SCHOOL MEAL SERVICE

Grab & Go breakfast is available in Commons I, and lunch is available in both Commons I and Commons II cafeterias. All other concept lunches, such as Deli, LA Cucina, Coyote Grill, Ruby Grill, and Real Meals, will be available in Commons I and II. Students must enter their PIN codes at the register to account for free breakfasts/lunches and purchase à la carte items such as water, snacks, 2nd lunch, etc.

- **Breakfast and lunch will be available every school day**
- **Preorder: No Longer Available**
- **Meal Payment:** Reimbursable meals are FREE for ALL Lexington Public School students (one breakfast and lunch per student). Student accounts will be charged for any a la carte items or additional meals using their PIN or student ID card. Please ensure your student(s) have a positive account balance before purchasing a la carte items or extra meals.
- **Additional information:** Breakfast and lunch will be provided on all half days in SY 2025-2026.
