

Kelsey (Watson) Maxwell graduated from Newfound Regional High School in 2006 and has been selected an inductee into the 2021 Newfound Athletics Hall of Fame because of her achievements as an athlete. Kelsey was a 3 year varsity member of the field hockey and girls basketball teams and a 4 year member of the track team. She was a captain of the field hockey and the girls basketball team during her senior year.

As a 3 sport athlete, Kelsey left her mark on all of her teams as a positive role model and leader. On the track, she still holds 4 records to this day. Her records include: 100m (12.8 s), 200m (26.2 s), 400m (58.2 s), and the 4x100 relay team (anchor). Kelsey went on to compete in the Meet of Champions during her junior and senior seasons. She even qualified for New England's during her junior year in the 400m.

Outside of athletics, Kelsey was a tremendous student and contributor to the culture at Newfound. Some of her school activities included being a member of the Student Council, Vice President of her class, and on the National Honor Society in which she was the president during her senior year.
