School Safety Month in the State of Ohio - Dr. Fineseke, Jasa George, Rose Gaiffe

- School Safety is a priority in the District
- District
 - All Staff is trained in ALICE (federal program that most districts use Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate); official safety training for District
 - Raptor System in place for all visitors, volunteers and vendors
 - Quick background check and alerts to any issues
 - Applied for an won multiple security grants
 - Security camera upgrades and training for safety (physical, social-emotional health)

JHHS

- One use is to put in door locks, over the hinge, down at the bottom, over the handle lock - each classroom has 1 of the three types of additional door locks
- Fire Drill required each month
- Tornado Drill March, April, and June (if in school)
- Safety Drills must do at least every three years
 - Table Top talk about what should be done; try to do at the beginning of each year so students know what to do in an emergency
 - Functional Drill Presented scenarios and discussing with students; will be done in November this year - how do you act and react in these situations, active shooter drills
 - Full-scale Will do a full-scale reunification drill during professional development day. We picked two new reunification sites (Epworth and University of Toledo)

 - Social Inclusion
 - Suicide Awareness and Prevention
 - Insert topic
- Social Emotional Surveys
- Ohio Safety Center
 - Great, free resource for the District

- Locks like JHHS
- Cameras
- Looking at new playground equipment and lowered equipment on playground to make safer
- Lockdown drill next week
- Social Emotional Drill
- Had a tornado drill at beginning of year
- Fire drills regularly

Questions

- Do the buildings have bulletproof glass/windows/doors?
 - District is applying for grants to improve doors, it is a film that goes over the doors
- Is there a plan to get a camera for the front of school?
 - Yes, it is in the works
- How do you let Volunteers know what to do during drills or events?
 - Great feedback, this is something we need to consider and improve on
- How do we communicate the information to elementary students?
 - Part of Alice training, keeping the kids away from doors and windows
- Has the staff done Bleed Stop training? (to stop traumatic bleeding)
 - Both buildings have kits
- If something big were to happen, do other departments respond?
 - Yes, multiple agencies respond in addition to OHPD UT, Sylvania,
 City of Toledo, Metroparks, etc.
- How are students transported for reunification?
 - TARTA sends busses

 - Examining costs and achieving savings whenever we can, switching banks to save
 \$14k annually for the district
 - Teacher contract negotiations
