November 11, 2020 Board Minutes

The board meeting of the HLV Community School District was held on November 11, 2020, at 5:03 p.m. President Hawkins called the meeting to order.

Roll call resulted in board members Hollopetter, Hawkins, Doran and Kolesar being present. Blomme was absent, a quorum was declared. Also present was Superintendent Hohensee, Cory Lahndorf, Karla Robison, and Lori McClenathan.

Doran read the Mission Statement "Teaching our Youth of Today to be Leaders of Tomorrow". Hawkins then read the President's Statement.

Hollopetter motioned to approve the consent agenda items, which included approval of the previous meeting minutes amending the minutes of the October meeting to read 409.3R2 not 409.3R3, approval of current bills and additional bills, approval of financial reports, facility use requests, open enrollment request from Blake Wolf from Belle Plaine, seconded by Kolesar, unanimously adopted.

Kolesar motioned to approve The Iowa County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for 2020-2025, seconded by Doran, unanimously adopted.

Kolesar motioned to approve the second reading of policies 106, 414, 501.9E1, 604.11, 907, and 907.R1, seconded by Hollopetter, unanimously adopted.

Doran motioned to approve the second readings to rescind policies 409.4, 409.5, 409.6, 409.7, 409.8, 414.1, 414.2, 414.3, 414.4, 414.5, 414.6, 414.7, and 414.8 seconded by Kolesar, unanimously adopted.

Hollopetter motioned to approve the second readings of policies 409.1, 409.2, 409.3, 409.3E1, 409.3E2, 409.3R1, 409.3R2, 501.9, and 601.2, seconded by Kolesar, unanimously adopted.

Doran motioned to approve the resolution of the Iowa County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan 2020-2025, seconded by Kolesar, unanimously adopted.

There was a discussion on winter sports and Covid related information.

Motion by Doran to approve the request for Modified Supplemental Aid for Open Enrollment out in the amount of \$55,040.00, seconded by Hollopetter, unanimously adopted.

Kolesar motioned to approve the bid from T & ST Enterprise for snow removal, seconded by Doran, unanimously adopted.

Under the Superintendent's report, Hohensee presented his November schedule. He discussed the Iowa county and Poweshiek County Covid positivity rates. The Board will begin policy review of section 200 in December, and approve the section in January. The IASB Convention is a virtual event this year, board members may attend online. December board meeting is scheduled for Wednesday December 9 at 5:00pm. The auditors performed the 2019-2020 audit this week. The Board Legislative In-Service is scheduled for January 28th at 6:00 pm at the MJM Community Center. We will monitor county rates and participation numbers and may have to cancel this event for the year. New furniture for the student

center was delivered this week replacing benches from 1977. There was a discussion regarding online learning and remote learning for quarantine students.

Principal Lahndorf reported on remote learning, attendance, and quarantines. A special Thank You to all that helped produce the virtual Veteran's Day Program, Mr. Lund, Mrs. Andrews, National Honor Society, students and staff.

Guidance Counselor Robison thanked Mr. Hohensee for obtaining a mental health grant. She has put a program into place for students.

The next regular school board meeting will be held Wednesday December 9, 2020 at 5:00 pm.
