After graduating Forsyth Central High School in 2009, Bonnie attended Georgia State University to pursue a BBA in Marketing. During that time, she followed in her mother’s footsteps and began teaching dance at Studio Dionne. She choreographed for the annual recitals as well as performed Kitri in their production of *Don Quixote*.

Summer 2015, Bonnie performed three shows with Tuacahn Center for the Arts in St. George, Utah, the first contract she booked out of New York. Her past productions include ensemble roles with the Atlanta Lyric in *The Producers*, *Guys and Dolls*, *Sophisticated Ladies*, *Spamalot*, *Chicago*, and *Cats* as well as *Chicago* at The Legacy Theatre, *The Thing About Men* with 7 Stages, and *Bullets Over Broadway*



with Georgia Ensemble Theatre. Some of her most recent performances in Atlanta include *Sleighbell Swings* and *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, both at the Cobb Energy Center, as well as the Atlanta Lyric Theatre’s *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels*, *A Chorus Line*, *Shrek* and *Beauty & the Beast*.

Her favorite role to date is Victoria, the white cat in *Cats*, with the Atlanta Lyric Theatre. Even with her triple threat capabilities, Bonnie’s favorite style of dance remains ballet. However, she plans to continue seeking opportunities in musical theatre and hopes it will take her to the Big Apple!
