## **Reading Cambridge Transcripts**

In the state of North Carolina, we read Cambridge transcripts using the following guidelines:

- 1. Review the school.
  - a. Is it a legitimate Cambridge School
  - b. Do they use the <a href="British system">British system</a>? (IE: kindergarten= grade 1, Grade 6 = fifth grade...)
  - c. Grades
- 2. IGCSE courses are considered honors students should receive the .5 grade boost.
- 3. Math: two years of IGCSE Math equals our Math 1-3.
- 4. English: two years if IGCSE equals English 1 and 2
- 5. AS and A level courses equal AP credits.
  - a. Students should receive a 1 GPA boost
  - b. If attending college in the US, students who receive an e/E on Cambridge Exams can earn college credit.
