

PETITION TO THE MCGILL ADMINISTRATION CONCERNING
THE VIOLATION OF STUDENT DEMOCRACY AND THE APPROVAL OF POLI 339

This letter is in response to the introduction and promotion of the POLI 339 course and condemns the McGill Administration and their involvement in the persistent marginalization of Palestinian, Arab, and Muslim students on campus. On January 30, the Arts Undergraduate Society (AUS) Legislative Council voted against a motion to approve the course fee for the 2019 POLI 339 summer course, which includes a two week exchange program at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. A few weeks later, members of the AUS Executive defied the Legislative decision and unconstitutionally approved the course in a secret vote, before communicating the “new” decision to the McGill Administration. As soon as it was publicized, [the decision was swiftly suspended by the AUS Secretary-General](#), and [one of the AUS Executives involved in the illegal vote resigned](#). The AUS subsequently requested that the administration respect the original binding AUS decision by reversing the course fee approval. However, the Deputy Provost for Student Life and Learning, Prof. Fabrice Labeau claimed there was no precedent for reversing a course fee approval — ignoring the fact that the course fee had been initially disapproved by the AUS.

The primary reason for students’ concern over the introduction and promotion of POLI 339 is the discriminatory treatment that Palestinian, Arab, and/or Muslim students would face. The Israeli border authorities’ violent and discriminatory methods are well-documented, ranging from harassment and hours-long interrogation to detainment and deportation. Since [2017](#), the Israeli parliament permits its border authorities to [expel](#) incoming travellers, [including students](#), who have criticized the state of Israel — be it through the Boycott Divest Sanction movement or not. Not only is this course part of a broader pattern of financing intellectually and ethically dishonest exchange programs between Canadian and Israeli universities, but its sponsors — the Gerald Schwartz & Heather Reisman Foundation — have funded scholarships for non-Israelis who enlist in the military. In addition, Schwartz founded Onex — a major private equity firm primarily concerned with military aircraft manufacturing. This course is therefore intellectually dishonest, because the source of its funding is strongly tied to the violent Israeli military occupation of Palestinian territories. In addition, the Hebrew University of Jerusalem is partially situated on illegally obtained land in East Jerusalem which was seized from Palestinian residents

in order to expand the campus of Mount Scopus. The University itself is therefore an active participant in the illegal settlement project in the occupied West Bank, which has repeatedly been condemned as a war crime by the United Nations.

The McGill administration has a long history of ignoring the ethical and violent ramifications of its decisions to operate, fund and promote numerous exchanges with Israeli institutions. Not only does that make McGill actively complicit in the Israeli state's internationally-condemned war crimes, but also puts its students of colour at risk by falsely implying that every student can safely take part in such courses. The principle of academic freedom should not be reduced to a pretext for the continued complicity with a brutal and illegal military occupation. We, as students and faculty at McGill who believe in and fight for the rights of students to feel safe, condemn the McGill administration for approving and promoting this course. ***We demand that McGill University show that it values justice, international law, and its students' safety as much as it values academic freedom by immediately cancelling this year's POLI 339 summer course and thereby respecting the decision made by the student councillors of the AUS council.***
