(The author is written in Times New Roman 12 pt., Center, Capitalize Each Word, without academic title)

Second Author

(If there is), (Second author is written in Times New Roman 12 pt, Center, Capitalize Each Word, without academic title)

Affiliation

(Affiliation is written in Times New Roman 12 pt., Center, Capitalize Each Word)

Email

(Email is written in Times New Roman 12 pt., Center. It's written just correspondence author)

Abstrak. The abstract is written in one paragraph that contains four components: (1) a statement of the problem, (2) research questions, (3) method, and (4) findings or results. The author can also write down things that are considered very important. The number of words in the abstract is 250 words with font 12 pt Times New Roman 1 space.

Keywords: contains special concepts (3-5 words/ phrases)

Introduction (Subheading; bolded with first capital letter)

The introduction should contain three things: (1) the problem being researched; (2) the reason why the problem is important; and (3) the research method, which is presented clearly and briefly. The introduction and others are written in Times New Roman font size 12 and 1 space. Foreign words are italicized and Arabic-Latin transliteration is based on the Arabic-Indonesian transliteration according to SKB 3 Menteri.

Discussion (Second subheading, written in bold with the first letter capitalized)

The content of the discussion is the main part of the article. This section consists of clear and scientific data and analyses using theory. This discussion is described comprehensively, logically, and systematically. If there is a table, it should be written in the following format:

The author writes conclusions from the results of the analysis, and then writes recommendations for future research. The author also expresses appreciation to those who have contributed to the research.
