 - DM Meeting Takeaways:
 1. ****Choral Festival Ensemble Size**
 - a. **12 now and for the foreseeable future NOT 17**
 2. Adjudication Evaluations - please do these!
 3. Adjudicators will now be charged cancellation fees
 4. Adjudicator Training is for all! Even just to observe
 5. Feedback - Gender-neutral language
 6. Adjudicators have requested more variety in repertoire (time periods, skills, etc.)
 7. At Choral Festival, the adjudicator who clinics does not need to turn in a rubric unless it is a 3 judge panel (3 scores must be present)
 8. Copyright Compliance:
 - a. Participants at events must use copyright compliant scores of music. **Each adjudicator must be presented with a copyright compliant score.** Directors will be required upon registration to *certify* that the legally required number of original copies have been purchased or secured for performance at this event.

- b. This means it is most important that adjudicators receive a copyright compliant score. Beyond that, directors will simply need to certify that they have been compliant. (i.e. 5 copies purchased with 60 kids on stage can be questioned, but if the director certifies that they own 60 copies, it's on them)
 - 9. HS can read JH/MS Advanced OR HS Primary
 - 10. Intermediate SR - can include ^4 (fi)
 - a. Practice sheet will be available
 - 11. Clinician consultant program! Use these funds!
 - a. **CAN** use for a Treble or Tenor-Bass Day
 - 12. Proposals: Board votes on policy and budget; actually have a specific proposal (solution oriented) - NOT feedback. Don't leave rationale blank, explain it. **Use proposal language.**
 - 13. Lots of proposals after meetings because people talk. LOOK at the proposals before you propose something to see if there is a similar one.
 - 14. **"Festival Experience"** - language? Thoughts? See open discussion below.

- Open discussion:
 - **Festival Experience:** Pedagogically aligns with programs to get the feedback and to get better/see other groups; legible comments, move to typing? Adjudicators need to give good feedback so the *comments* are why people bring their groups to festivals (they are being given this instruction at training) → for **Choral** festival. To do this, we must make sure the adjudicators have breaks, we are asking too much of adjudicators who must score and clinic with no breaks. Some schools would give up rating to have more time with clinician
 - Does S&SE do this too? Festival Experience and FE + rating?
 - Festival Experience language lessens the stress on new teachers who are scared to get ratings

- Event Ideas for D4 Colleague events?
 - Brought favorite song their choir sang that year and just sang through rep (like a mini reading session), at a spring meeting or outside
 - Fall, Winter, Spring director events
